Check-In ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. OTCWF is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

MEASURING



All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.


There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it will only get you through the weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. It will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

<u>It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their</u> dog measured prior to running.

RUNNING ORDERS AND COURSE MAPS



Each judge will supply course maps. Please take ONE copy so we will have sufficient copies for every exhibitor. Running orders will be posted near the entrance to each ring, along with

a copy of the course maps.



Arrival/Setup

The building should be open for set up at 6:30 a.m. all 3 days.

WE COULD USE SOME HELP UNLOADING THE TRAILER ON THURSDAY AT 12:00 NOON.

You may NOT setup on Thursday unless you are helping unload the trailer.

If you come to help unload the trailer on Thursday at noon, you may set up your crates, but you MUST help unload the trailer. If you come to Myers on Thursday intending to set your crates up, please be honorable and do the right thing...help unload the trailer. THANKS!

Please do not set up on the concrete walkway by the north side overhead door where vendors normally set up. We have some vendors who will be at the trial, and this area must remain open for them. Crating in the wash rack area is permitted.

Move-Ups

The pretrial move-up deadline is Monday, Feb 20 at 6:00 pm. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.



THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.

Open/Novice will walk together after Exc/Mas FAST has concluded. There will not be a course build in between. A "Send" for each level will be marked on the course. Open will be immediately followed by Novice - no walk thru or course build in between Open and Novice. Novice FAST will have 12 weave poles (which are optional on a FAST course).

Any and all assistance will be greatly appreciated. Your dog will really appreciate having nice dirt to run on every day.


