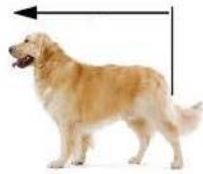

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card. **Our Judge Ms. Ratoza is a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO).** ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it. If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run.



Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

.... Will be available during the trial. Breakfast and lunch will be served at the concession stand on the concourse level. Sorry, outside food is not allowed.

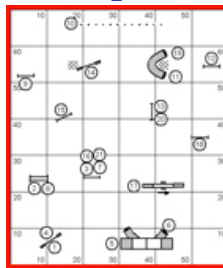

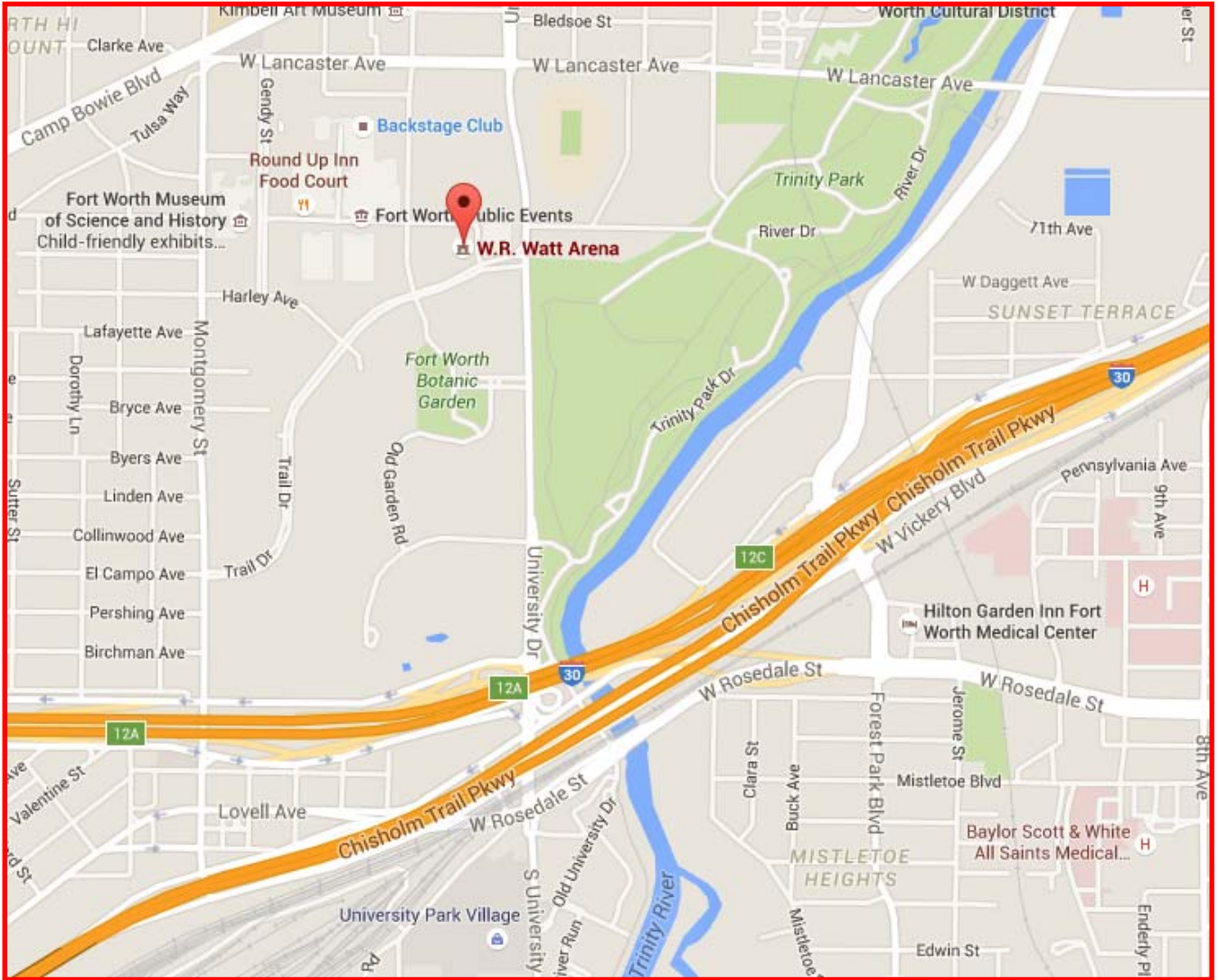

The Trial Site

From Interstate 30 just west of downtown Fort Worth, take the UNIVERSITY DR NORTH ramp around and turn left (North) on University Drive. Go .6 miles (6/10 of a mile) to the light at Harley Drive. Turn left onto Harley Drive. The building ahead on the right is Watt Arena.



RV PARKING

There are RV hookups and a dump station in the lot south of Harley at Montgomery Street and in the area next to the Swine Building; NO RESERVATIONS – first come, first served. All vehicles larger than a standard van must park in the lots one block south of the Museum of Science and History on Harley/Montgomery Streets. The area next to the Swine Building is paid RV parking ONLY. RV lots on Harley Street and west of the Swine Barn will have water and hookups. Parking on marked lots must be inside the designated lines.
