Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. OTCWF is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

MEASURING



All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC Rep comes, which is not scheduled at this time. Without an AKC Rep, measurements will not be official -- it will only get you through the weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. It will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than 6:00 pm on Monday, April 10, 2017.** Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Arrival/Setup

Set-up will be allowed on Thursday from 4 p.m. until 8 p.m., at 7:30 am on Friday, and 6:30 am on Saturday and Sunday.

NEW RULES FOR MPEC

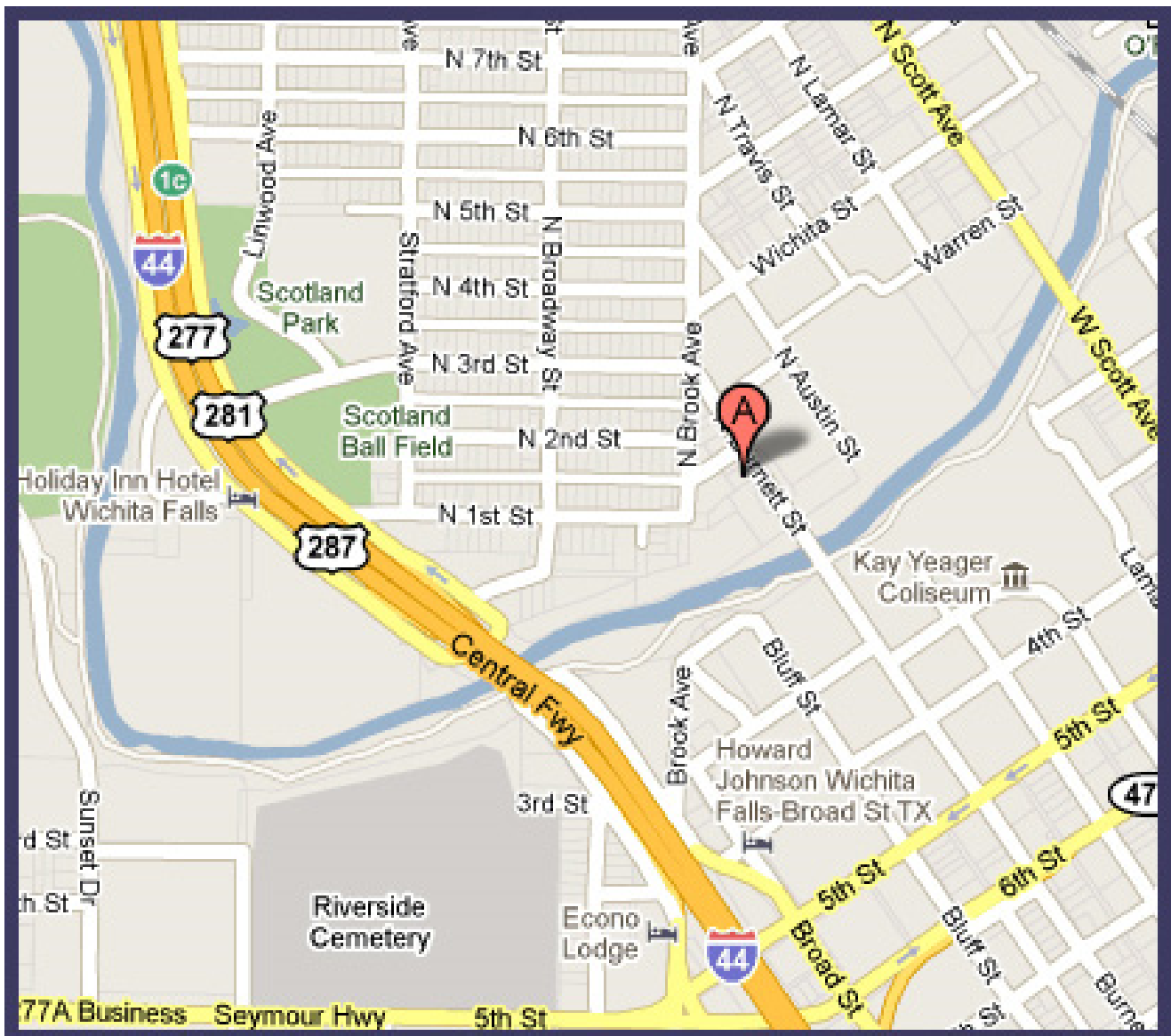

Exc/Mas will walk/run first (because of number of entries). Open/Novice will walk together after Exc/Mas FAST has concluded. There will not be a course build in between. A "Send" for each level will be marked on the course. Open will be immediately followed by Novice – no walk thru or course build in between Open and Novice. Novice FAST will have 12 weave poles (which are optional on a FAST course).

Walk-Thrus can be split at judge's discretion. Lunch will be taken at judge's discretion.
