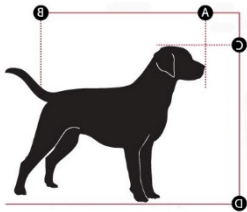

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height

card in case someone asks for it.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC rep is present (not expected). Due to Covid-19, Measurements (except by an AKC Rep if present) will not be taken at the trial.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on the Agility Gate App at any time prior to your class.

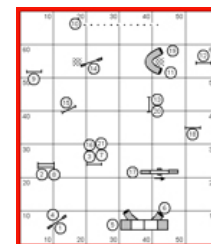

RUNNING ORDERS AND COURSE MAPS IMPORTANT!

Course maps will be posted per AKC Agility Regulations. **There will be no printed copies of course maps for exhibitors.** Exhibitors may take a picture of the posted course maps. Also, maps will be posted to the North Texas Agility website around 6:00 pm each evening before the next trial day. www.ntxagility.com and on the Agility Gate App.

A preliminary running order will be posted on the www.ntxagility.com website on or before Wednesday prior to the first day of the trial. No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the Agility Gate App for check-in on your phone.... **See Page 2 for more information.**

We will be utilizing the **AGILITY GATE APP**

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders remotely. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

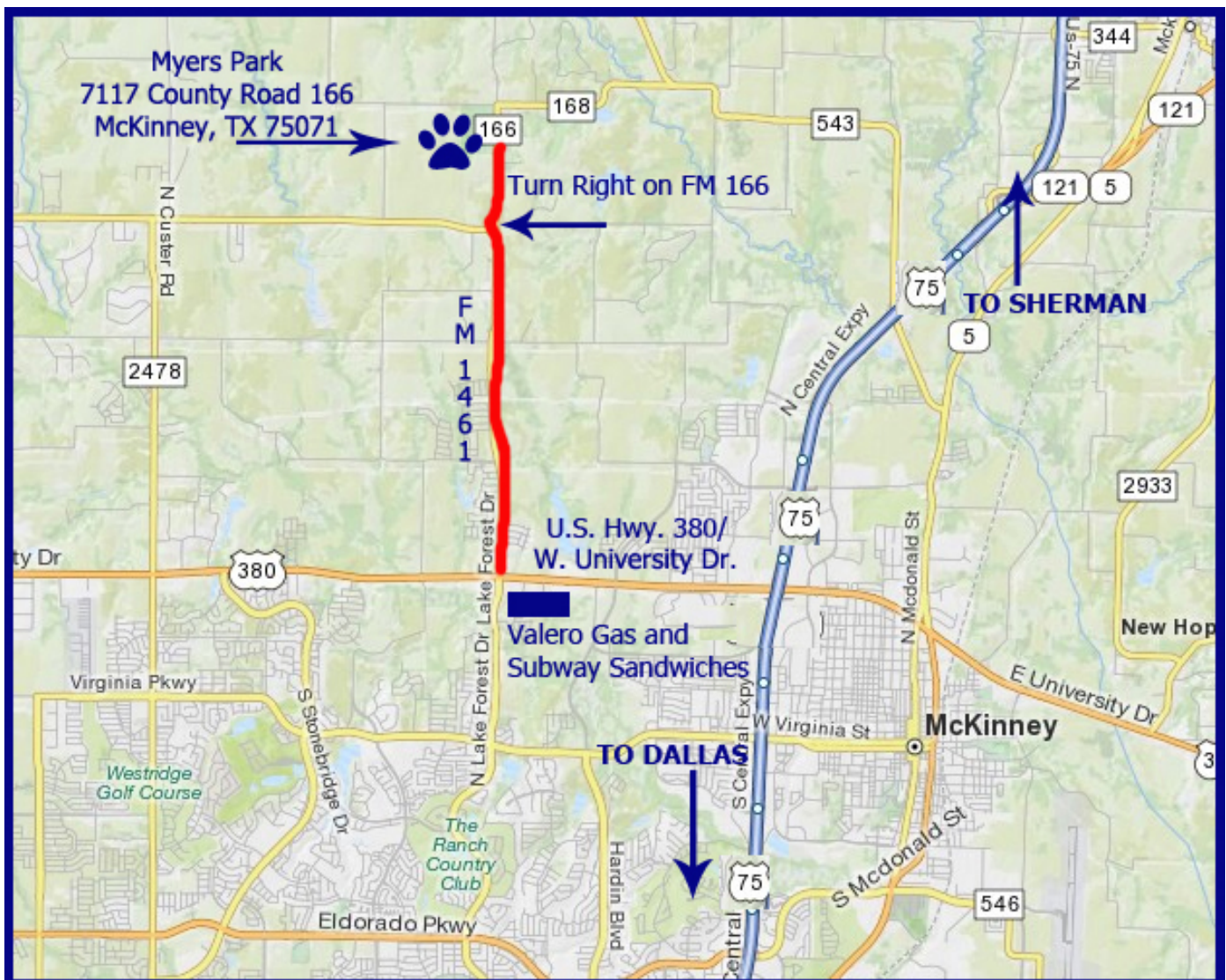
Course maps will be posted on the Agility Gate App as well as at www.ntxagility.com each evening prior to the trial.

THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.



PLEASE READ ENTIRELY!

Covid Guidelines and Information for Exhibitors and Volunteers attending the Dallas Agility Working Group trial January 23rd & 24th , 2021, at Myers Park, McKinney, TX

1. Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines. Please stay informed of updates https://www.collincountytx.gov/healthcare_services/Pages/publicguidance.aspx and <https://www.texas.gov/Covid19/>.
2. Practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines. Avoid congregating as much as possible. Avoid shaking hands and hugging.
3. Mask must be worn at all times while in the building with two exceptions. You may remove your mask during your run, but you must put your mask on before exiting the ring. You may remove your mask for eating and drinking.
4. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at ringside, along with disinfectant and wipe .
5. Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own.
6. Crating should be at least six feet apart, except for “family” groups of exhibitors consisting of 10 or less.
7. Surfaces in common use areas will be disinfected as often as possible (tables, chairs, gate latches, etc.) If you are working in the ring, please consider using your own chair.
8. No shared food items are permitted. This means no MACH cakes are allowed. A food truck will be available on site, and there are many take-out options near the show site. Consider bringing your own refreshments. Bottled water will be provided for the Ring Crew.
- 9 The Agility gate app will be used at this event. You will check yourself in on the app. The scribe will be marking off people on app when run is complete so you can see who is in the ring next on the monitors outside the rings.
10. Check in at the table on arrival. A volunteer will collect your completed COVID Waiver, mark you present on the appropriate gate sheets, and give you your wrist band.
11. There will be no self-serve ribbons. Ribbons handed out on request.
12. Leash Runner can either use paper towels to handle each leash; can apply hand sanitizer between handling of each leash; or use a “grabber”, which will be wiped down between leashes.
13. Course Builders will use hand sanitizer before and after setting courses. The measuring wheel will be wiped before/after each use. Only the Chief Course Builders will handle maps. DO NOT share course-building maps with others.
14. Timer/Scribe should sit at the ends of the table. The Scribe should only use their own pen. The table, timer console and chairs should be wiped down with each shift change. Scribe sheets will be placed in a basket that will be taken to the Trial Secretary by the scribe runner.
15. Briefings may be done over a PA system/ring speaker so exhibitors may stay spread out. Exhibitors do not have to come into the ring for briefing – they may stay outside of the ring. Briefings will not be required for Excellent/Master level classes.
16. No measuring will be done by the judge of record. Should a VMO attend the trial, they may choose to not measure dogs. If they agree to, the measuring devices and table should be wiped down between dogs. VMO should consider wearing a mask and must sanitize their hands between dogs.
17. Walk-throughs will be split in groups of no more than approximately 25 exhibitors. If there is more than one group for a class, the first dog is to be on the start line immediately after the last group walks. No 5-minute break.
18. Results will be posted on the washroom wall. Course maps will be posted on bleachers, which will also be available at <https://ntxagility.com/> and on the Agility Gate App on the evening before the trial. Exhibitors may take pictures of the maps with their smart devices.
19. Exhibitors may place leashes in their pockets when running the course or wear on themselves (i.e., clip like a belt around the waist). Note: if the dog grabs the leash while running this will be scored as an “E”.

MYERS PARK

Myers Park allows overnight parking for motor homes and/or travel trailers. Electric is available in the back parking lot. Hookups are not available if you choose to set up in the front parking lot. \$15/night (more for electric in the back)– Call **972-548-4792** to make arrangements. The main gate will not be locked at night. **If you park in the front parking lot, you may NOT park in front of The Landing (small building to the north of the show barn). You must park in front of the Show Barn or the Stall Barn only.** Please pay Myers Park personnel at the show site. The event committee cannot accept payment.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.
