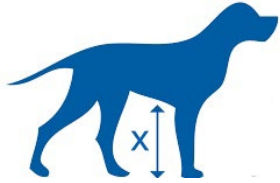

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if

asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our Judge, Lisa Selthofer is a Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the ribbon-label table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it. **If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in removal of any qualifying runs you receive.**

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on the Agility Gate App at any time prior to your class.

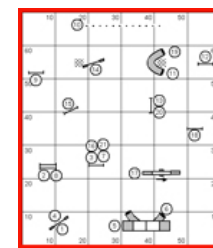

We will be utilizing the **AGILITY GATE APP**

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders remotely. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

ISC RULE REMINDERS

**TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZES IN THE ISC CUP,
YOU MUST BE ENTERED IN ALL 4 FCI / ISC RUNS ON FRIDAY**

Prizes (for ISC Cup Only):

- Dogs placing in the top 3 combined score in each jump height will be awarded a dog toy valued at less than \$5.
- To be eligible for the overall ISC cup podium awards, you must be entered in all 4 ISC runs in both trials on Friday.
- Runs will be scored time plus faults. All faults are 5 secs and elimination is 100 secs.
- The top 3 combined winners per height will be on the podium and receive prizes.

WORLD TEAM TRYOUT QUALIFYING RULES:

This event is also a World Team Qualifying Event, so the following will apply to those who would like to be eligible for the World Team Tryouts for the 2023 Team:

- ISC Combined Class Winners Combined **scores from Trial 2 ISC JWW and Trial 2 STD classes** at this event will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award.
- To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award, the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score.
- The Combined Class winner from the 12, 16 , 20 and 24 inch heights in Trial 2 will receive an automatic invite to attend Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill the requirement of the 4/4 scores.
- The team must also send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility as noted in the World Team Tryout Rules that can be found at <https://www.akc.org/sports/agility/events/usa-world-agility-team/>.
- The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

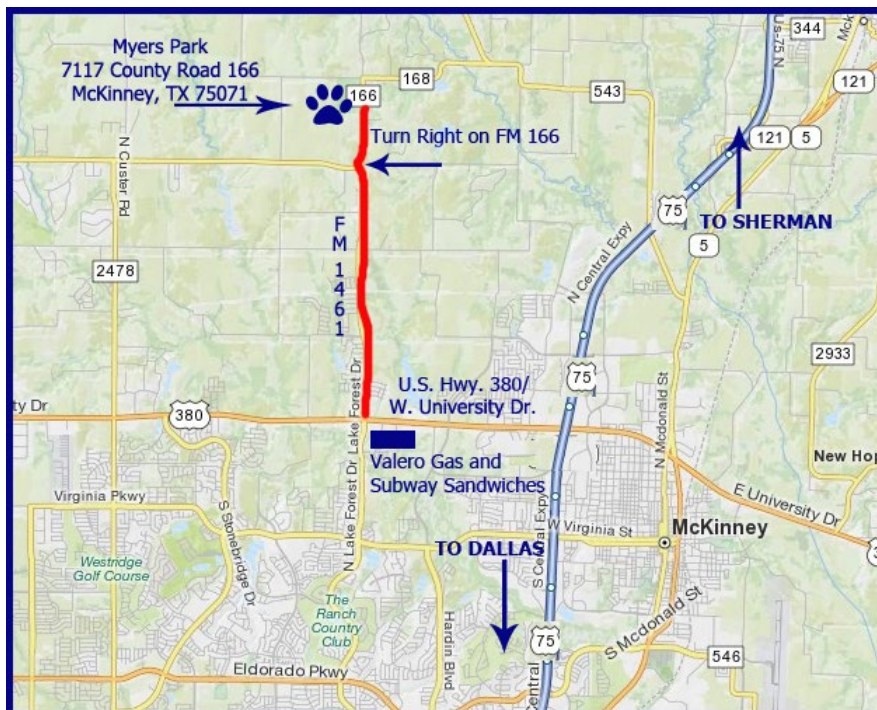

From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.

MYERS PARK

Myers Park allows overnight parking for motor homes and/or travel trailers. Electric is available in the back parking lot. Hookups are not available if you choose to set up in the front parking lot. \$15/night (more for electric in the back)– Call **972-548-4792** to make arrangements. The main gate will not be locked at night. **If you park in the front parking lot, you may NOT park in front of The Landing (small building to the north of the show barn). You must park in front of the Show Barn or the Stall Barn only.** Please pay Myers Park personnel at the show site. The event committee cannot accept payment.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.
