

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your

height card in case someone asks for it.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC rep is present (not expected). Measurements will not be official -- it is only to make sure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. Measuring will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.

A COUPLE OF IMPORTANT NOTES....

PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR DOGS POTTY INSIDE THE BUILDING. IF AN ACCIDENT HAPPENS, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CLEAN IT UP.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Myers Park allows overnight parking for motor homes and/or travel trailers. Electric is available in the back parking lot. The main gate will not be locked at night. If you park in the front parking lot, you may NOT park in front of The Landing (small building to the north of the show barn).
