Measuring All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able

to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our Judge is NOT a measuring official. Unless an AKC rep is present at the trial (not expected), there will not be a Measuring Official (VMO) at the trial and measurements will not be required. If your dog does not have any permanent measurements, you must have your dog measured by the judge to make sure your dog is jumping in the correct jump height for this weekend only.

### Check-In ARMBAND STICKERS NOT **REQUIRED**

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), The Club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the Agility Gate App for check-in on your phone or iPad.... See Page 2 for more information.



Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.

### PLEASE BE AWARE....

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds.** Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel or show facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

**PLEASE REMEMBER:** Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Pease clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others.
