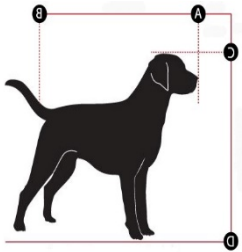

## Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in

case someone asks for it.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC rep is present (not expected). Due to Covid-19, Measurements will not be taken at the trial.

## Check-In

(Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), DenTex will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in on your phone.... See Page 2 for more information.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

**The access code is 1010.**

## **DFWESSA COVID 19 GUIDELINES**

- ✓ If we must cancel the trials, we will notify everyone and issue full refunds/return vouchers.
- ✓ If a competitor tests positive for Caronavirus or has to be quarantined due to exposure after entering, they will be issued a full refund.
- ✓ Protective face masks will be required when not running your dog / outside of the ring.
- ✓ Social distancing (not gathering in groups closer than 6 feet apart) will be practiced within the building and on its grounds and in the parking areas.
- ✓ There will be no shared food, no MACH/PACH cakes. Plan to bring your own food.
- ✓ Ring crew of the same 6-10 people will be provided both days. If we have a leash runner, a leash grabber will be used and sanitized between the handling of each leah. AKC is allowing you to run with the leash in your pocket if it fully fits.,
- ✓ Ribbons will not be self-serve.
- ✓ Bring your own pen. No community pens or markers will be available.
- ✓ Course maps will not be printed. Plan to take a picture of posted maps. Maps will also be available on the Agility Gate App.
- ✓ Vendors will not be allowed
- ✓ Please be patient as we navigate through these unknown times. We will make decisions as we go based on the information available.
- ✓ **COVID-19 Health Acknowledgement, Waiver and Release must be completed and turned in at the check-in table. You will be given an armband when you check in with your signed Waiver and Release. Everyone must wear their armband all weekend in the facility. Exhibitors may not run without an armband.**

I, as a participant (or the participant's parent/legal guardian), registered attendee, contractor, volunteer or event sponsor, am aware of the potential spread of COVID-19 that could result in severe illness and potential death. 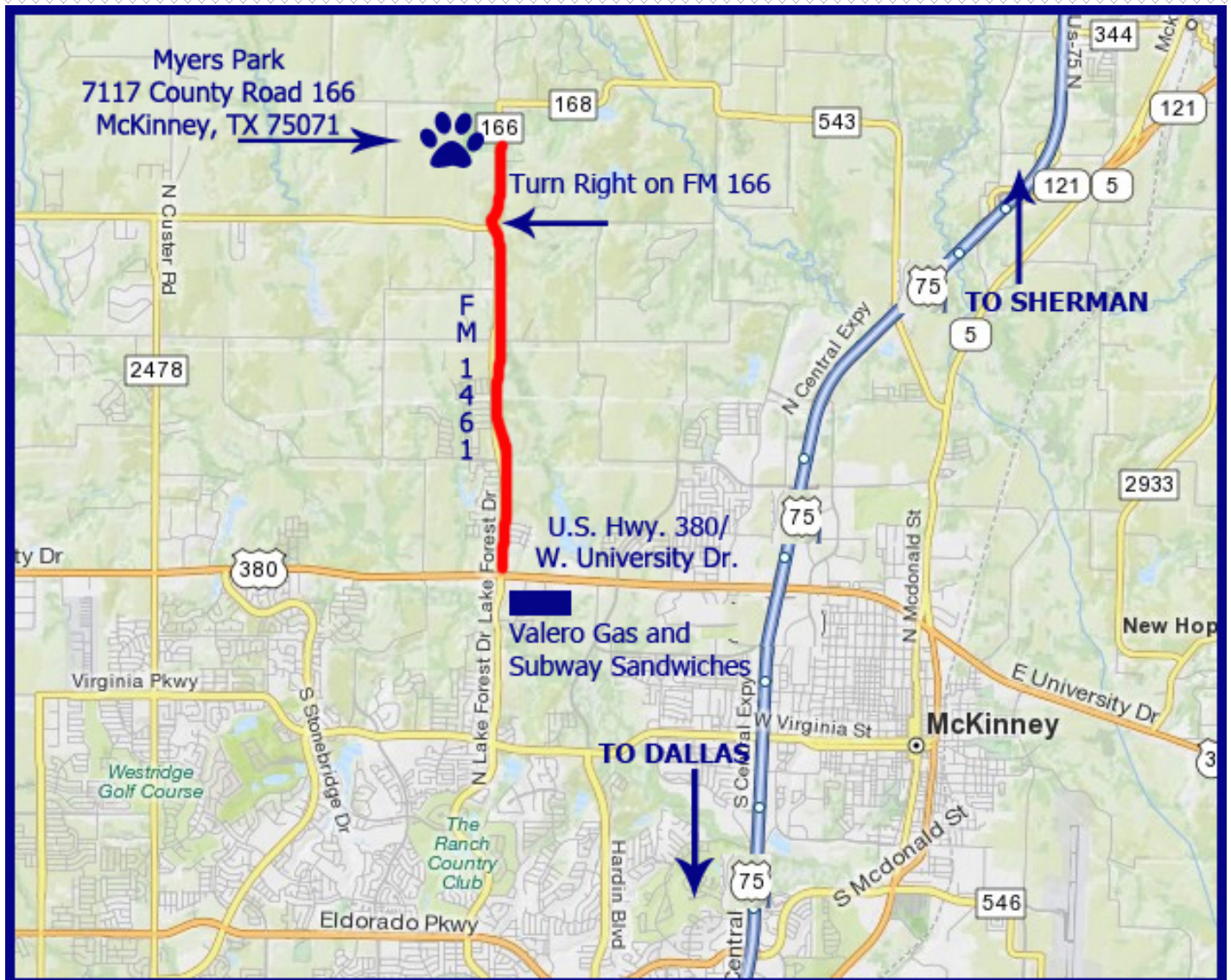

### PLEASE BE AWARE....

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds.** Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel or show facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

**PLEASE REMEMBER:** Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels.
