Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked.

Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our Judge, Don Farage, is a measuring official. ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. **Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured.** Official Measurements can be done throughout the day. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

(Armbands Not Required)

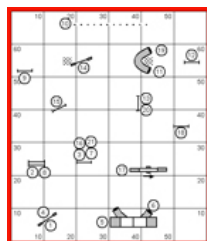
Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

IMPORTANT CRATING INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ

There will be a Barn Hunt trial going on in the south (large) crating area. Agility competitors should crate on the north side of the building (the area on the opposite side of the rings from the concession area). Competitors who are entered in Barn Hunt and agility should crate in the Barn hunt area. Overflow can crate in the Barn Hunt area, but Barn Hunt has precedence in that area.

We will be utilizing the [AGILITY GATE APP](#) for the exhibitors' convenience.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

The access code is 1010.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Some printed maps will be available for those not using their phone or tablet. Maps will not be posted on Agility Gate or the North Texas Agility website.

IMPORTANT DFWESSA COVID 19 GUIDELINES

- ✓ If a competitor tests positive for Caronavirus or must be quarantined due to exposure after entering, they will be issued a full refund.
- ✓ Protective face masks are **highly recommended** when not running your dog / outside of the ring. The Barn Hunt trial is requiring masks at all times, so if you go to the Barn Hunt area, please respect their rules and wear a mask.
- ✓ Ribbons will be self-serve.
- ✓ Course maps will be posted for exhibitors to take a picture of. There will be some printed copies available for those who choose not to use their phone or tablet.
- ✓ **Turn in a signed waiver (at the end of the judging program) when you arrive at the trial site.**

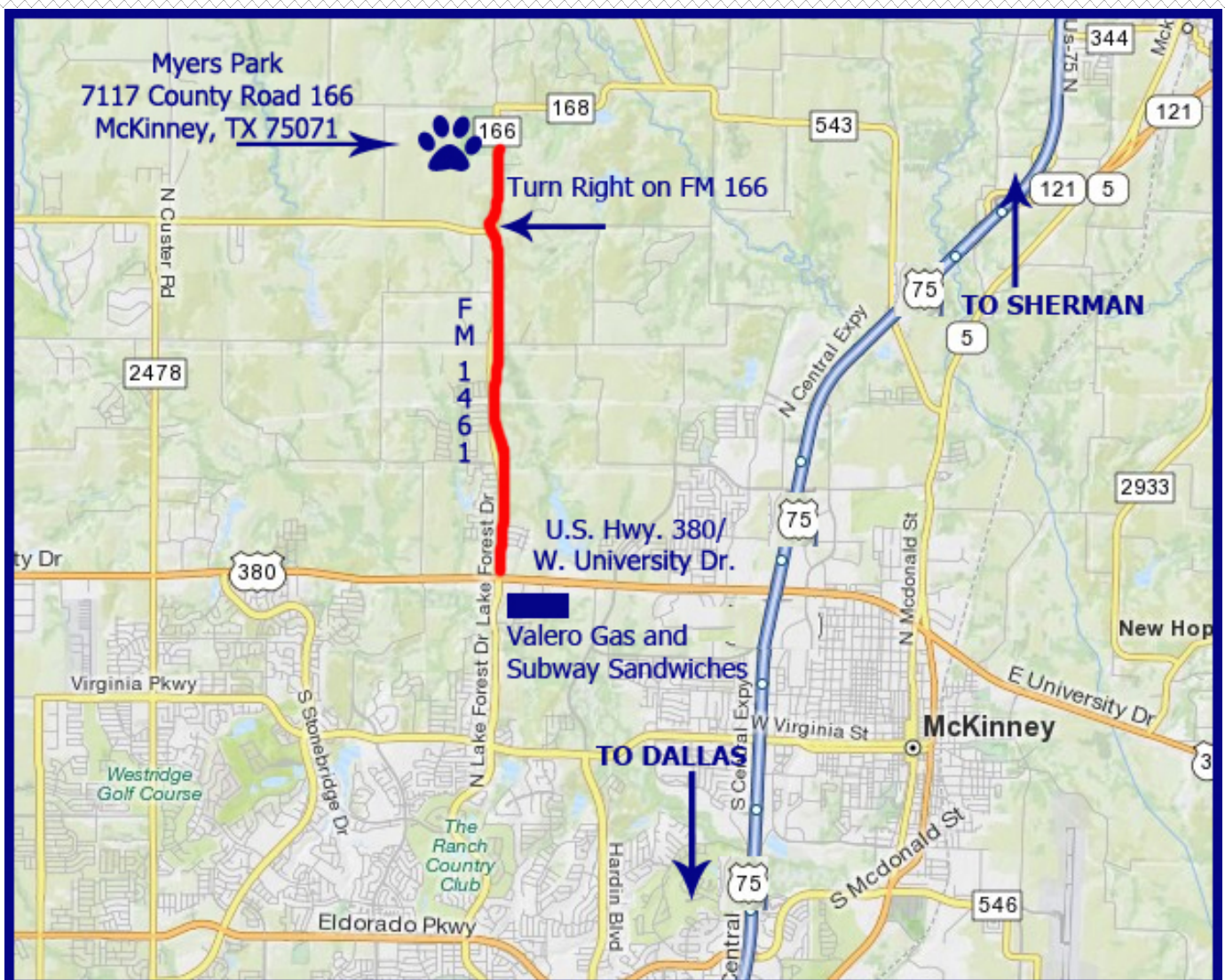

The Trial Site

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
