CHECK-IN & MEASUREMENTS

. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

There will not be a VMO (Measuring Official) at the trial unless an AKC Rep comes (not expected). ALL dogs (except dogs jumping 24") without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured by one of the judges before their first run of the weekend to make sure you are entered in the correct jump height. The judges can measure in between classes all day. Be sure to allow enough time prior to your first run to get a measurement.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

DFWMGRC does not require armband stickers.

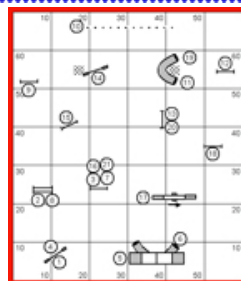

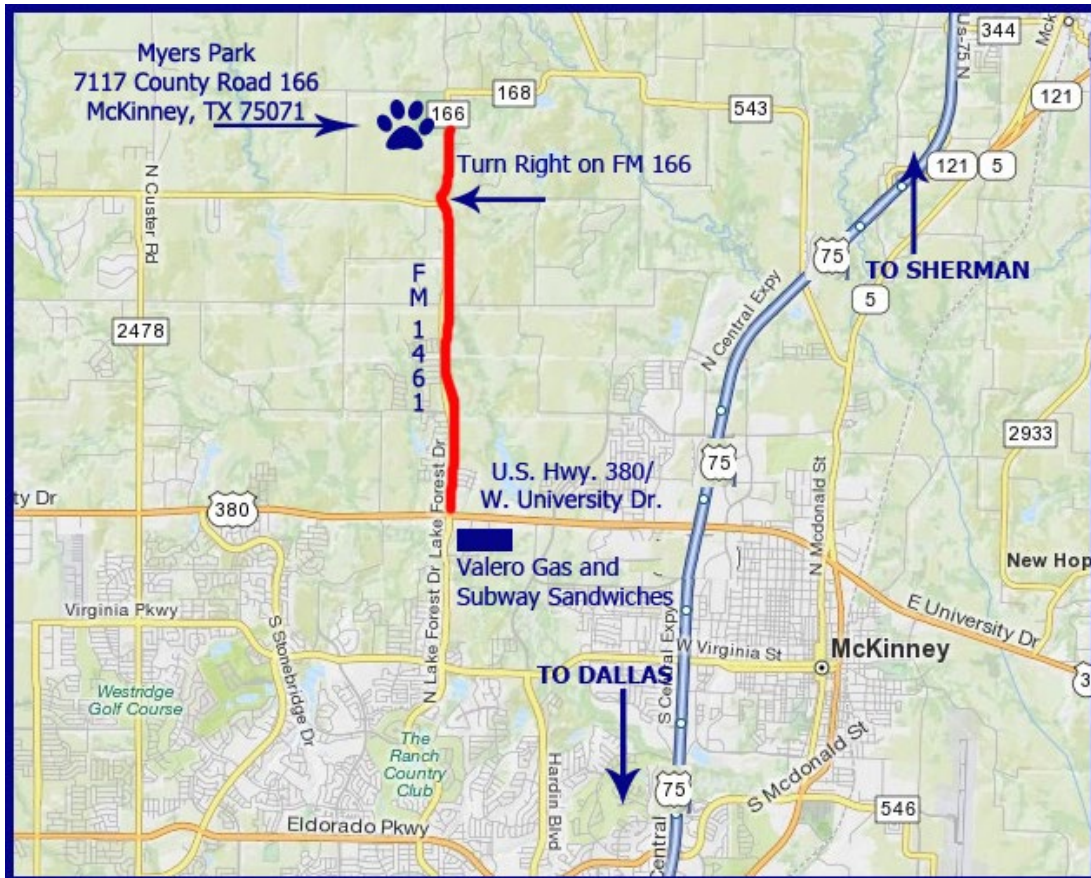

THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.

MYERS PARK

Myers Park allows overnight parking for motor homes and/or travel trailers. Electric hookups are available on the back parking lot. Parking is also allowed on the front parking lot with no hookups. Call **972-548-4792** to make arrangements. The main gate will not be locked at night. **Pay Myers Park personnel at the show site. The event committee cannot accept payment.**

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds.

Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
