Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

There will be an AKC Rep at the trial so official measurements will be done. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running. If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. It will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in ON Agility Gate. Additionally, please mark conflicts and absences on Agility Gate.

Concessions...

...will be available during the trial. Breakfast and lunch will be served at the concession stand on the concourse level. Sorry, outside food is not allowed.



Running Orders and Course Maps

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC rules. Maps for the following day will be posted each evening after 6:00 pm at www.ntxagility.com and on Agility Gate. Individual maps will not be available during the trial.



Arrival/Setup

There is no early set up on Thursday. You may begin setting up at 6:30 am all three days.

IMPORTANT: Unloading/Loading on Fri., Sat. & Sun. will NOT be permitted through the overhead door on the west side of the arena. Unloading/Loading will have to be done through the north doors/ramps to the arena on Burnett-Tandy Drive.

We will start unloading the trailer at 6:00 am Friday morning. If anyone would like to help, it would be greatly appreciated.

DIRECTIONS TO THE PARC: Exit the show site by going left on Trail Dr. Turn south (right) on University Dr to I-30 W. In approximately 8/10 of a mile, turn right onto West Freeway. Merge onto I-30 West. In approx. .23 miles, take Exit 10 toward Hulen St. Stay on West Freeway and exit (turn left) onto Merrick St. Turn left over freeway and turn left onto the Eastbound service road. The PARC is located on the south side of I-30 east of Merrick Street. (Approximately 5-10 minutes from show site) on the right.

Move-Ups:

The pretrial move-up deadline is Monday, August 23 at 6:00 pm. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

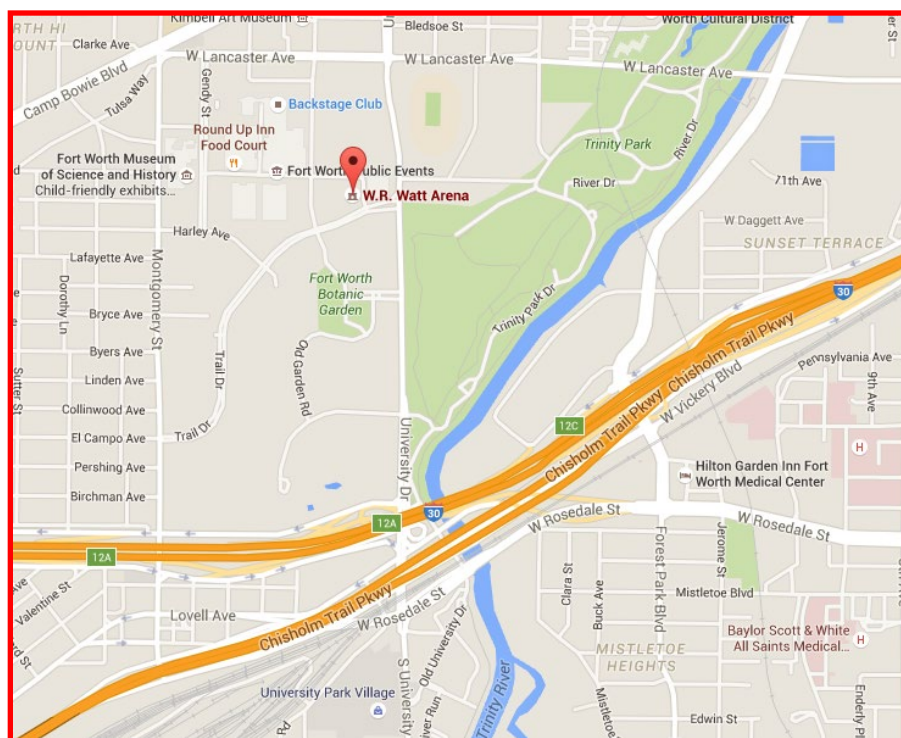
PARKING AT WATT ARENA

From Interstate 30 just west of downtown Fort Worth, take the UNIVERSITY DR NORTH ramp around and turn left (North) on University Drive. Go .6 miles (6/10 of a mile) to the light at Harley Drive. Turn left onto Harley Drive. The building ahead on the right is Watt Arena.
