Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.



There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC rep is present (not expected). Due to Covid-19, Measurements will not be taken at the trial.

Check-In

(Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), DenTex will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in on your phone.... See Page 3 for more information.

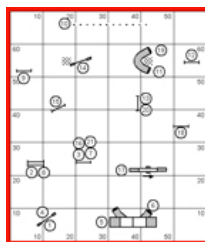

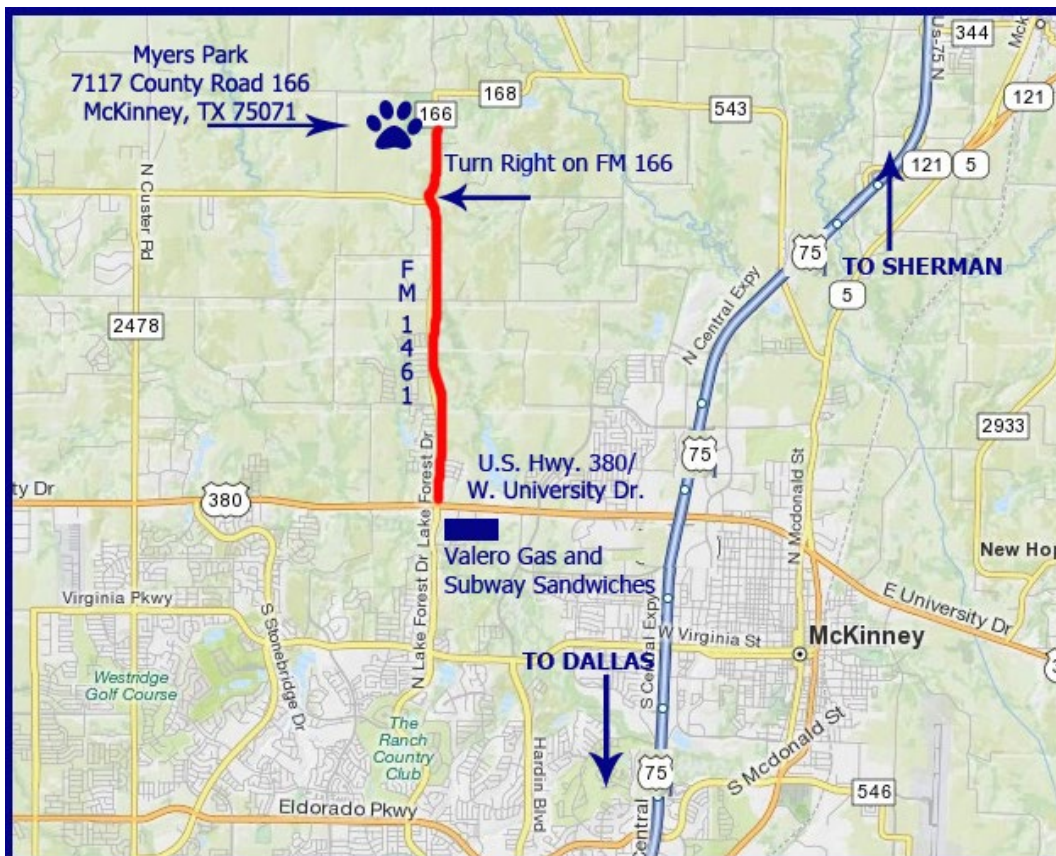

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
