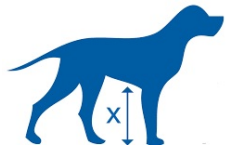

## Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

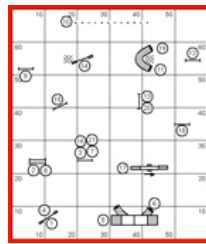
There will not be a Measuring Official at this trial unless an AKC rep is present (not expected). Due to Covid-19, the judge will not do temporary measurements at the trial.

## Check-In

(Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), DenTex will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in on your phone or iPad.... See Page 2 for more information.

## **DENTEX FACE MASK POLICY**

**Masks must be properly worn at all times when in the Lucky Dog Training Center...**

**EXCEPT WHEN RUNNING YOUR COURSE**

Failure to comply with this policy may result in you being asked to leave the event grounds and may result in an Event Committee hearing and disciplinary action.

Agility is a voluntary activity, and for the safety of all attendees, adherence to this mask policy is mandatory.

**There are no exceptions, regardless of vaccine status.**

All attendees (ages 2 and up) are required to bring and wear a face mask at all times while within the Myers Park Show Barn. You may remove the face mask while actively eating or drinking, but you must be stationary and maintain appropriate physical distancing. No eating or drinking will be permitted ringside. Eating and drinking will be done within as short amount a time as possible.

**All face masks (whether disposable or reusable) must:**

- **Be made with at least two or more layers and not have valves or vents**
- **If using a disposable mask, it should be changed daily and disposed of properly**
- **Fully cover the nose and mouth and fit snugly against the sides of your face without gaps**
- **Be secured with ties or ear loops and allow the attendee to remain hands-free**
- **If you are using a face shield you must also wear a face mask.**

The following are **not** permitted: Gaiters, Bandanas, masks with valves/vents/mesh material or holes of any kind.

As important as they are, face masks are only one source of prevention, all attendees will be required to comply with all attendee protocols. The attendee protocols and this Face Mask Policy are subject to change without notice.

**The face mask must be worn so that it that covers your mouth and nose.**

There will be no public access to the Events. Approved attendees include Judges, Exhibitors, Event staff, handlers, owners of entered dogs. Minors must have their own signature as well as signature of a parent or legal guardian. **You will be issued a wristband that you must wear at all times for the duration of your stay and show on entering the facility.** If your wristband is lost or broken, you must re-submit all forms. If you cannot affirm any of these of these statements, DO NOT come onto Event Grounds. All questions should be directed to [jpxagility@gmail.com](mailto:jpxagility@gmail.com).

Everyone will be required to follow social distancing guidelines. This means maintaining six feet of distance from others, not congregating at ringside, following wayfinding signs (as applicable) and remaining within designated set-ups. Exhibiting will be "Show and Go" where possible.

**We only want to see your dog's nose, not yours.**

## Self-Declaration & Waiver

**TURN THIS IN AT CHECK-IN TABLE UPON ARRIVAL TO RECEIVE A WRISTBAND.**  
**A WRISTBAND IS REQUIRED FOR EVERYONE IN THE BUILDING.**

I attest to the following:

1. Within the last 14 days, I have not-
  - experienced any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 nor tested positive for COVID-19 (other than what might be normal for your personal health status – allergies etc.)
  - been in close contact (being within six feet of an infected individual for at least 10 minutes) with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 unless as a medical professional equipped with PPE.
2. I have read the DenTex Face Mask Policy and understand that I will be required to properly wear a compliant mask at all times while within the Facilities.
3. I am not waiting on results of a COVID-19 test, nor is anyone else in my household. I am not under any self-quarantine at this time.
4. I agree to fully comply with: (i) any health and safety protocols and mitigation measures implemented by DenTex Agility Club, Lucky Dog Training Center, and/or AKC; and (ii) all local, state and federal requirements, (collectively, the “Attendee Protocols”) while attending the Event (an agility event at Lucky Dog Training Center hosted by DenTex Agility Club May 7, 8, 9, 2021 (the “Event”).
5. I agree that if my health should change while attending the Event, I will immediately leave the event and facility and seek medical guidance.
6. I agree that if, while attending the Event, I test positive for COVID-19, experience any symptoms, or am exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, I will notify the trial chair promptly and will not reenter the trial grounds.

### **WAIVER**

I am fully aware of the risks involved with entering DenTex Agility Club/TWANG (the “Club”) events held at facilities located at Lucky Dog Training Center, Tyler, Texas (the “Facilities”) during the COVID-19 pandemic (or with respect to any related or similar infection, which together are herein referred to as “COVID”). I am entering into this Waiver knowingly and on my own behalf. As a condition of my being allowed to enter the Facilities, I will fully comply with: (i) any health and safety protocols and mitigation measures implemented by the Club, Facilities, and/or AKC; and (ii) all local, state and federal requirements, each of (i) - (ii) as amended from time to time (collectively, the “COVID Protocols”).

I acknowledge that the risks involved with attending the Event and being in the presence of other people during the COVID pandemic include, but are not limited to, contracting COVID-19, respiratory failure, death, and transmitting COVID to family or household members and others. I further understand that compliance with the COVID Protocols will not eliminate these risks.

I acknowledge that contact tracing and a full list of all known attendees will be provided to any and all health or governmental authorities as needed. I further acknowledge that HIPPA does NOT apply as the Club, its affiliates, and agents are not covered entities.

I elect to voluntarily attend the Event with full knowledge that doing so may be hazardous to my health and those with whom I may come into contact. I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any risks of loss or personal injury, including serious illness, injury or death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, as a result of my presence at the Event. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I release, waive, forever discharge and covenant not to sue the Club, their respective affiliates and each of the foregoing’s respective administrators, members, officers, volunteers, sponsors, vendors, contractors, judges, trial secretary, and agents (the “Releasees”) from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or related to any loss, damage, illness, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by me or by others who come into contact with me, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees, other entities or individuals, or otherwise as a result of, or related to, my decision to attend the Event or enter the Facilities.

I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREE THAT IT IS VALID FOREVER. It is my express intent that this Waiver binds; (i) the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and (ii) my heirs, assigns and personal representatives, if I am deceased. If any of the provisions, terms or clauses of this Waiver is declared illegal, unenforceable or ineffective in a legal forum, those provisions, terms and clauses shall be deemed severable, such that all other provisions, terms and clauses of this Waiver shall remain valid and binding upon both parties. By signing this Waiver, I waive my right to commence, or be a party to, any class actions or collective claims against the Releasees.

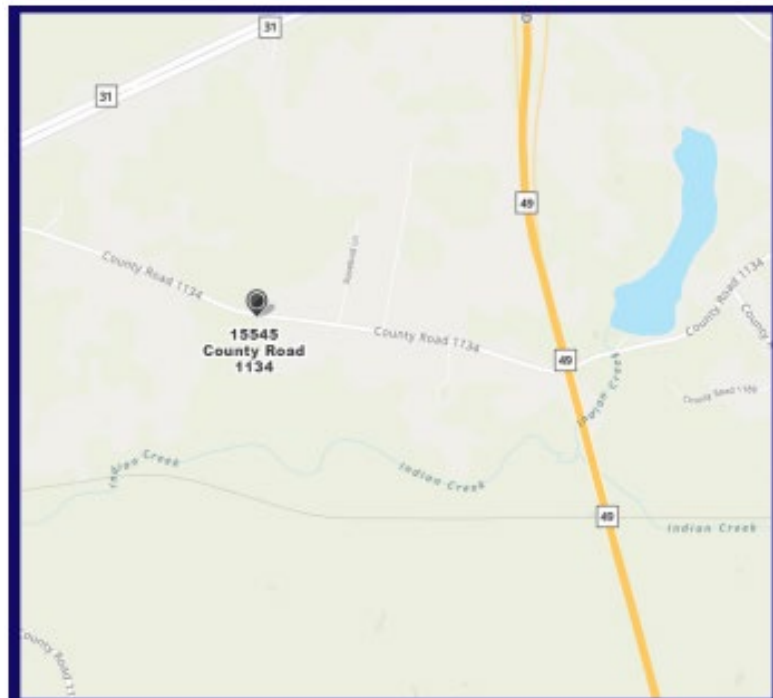
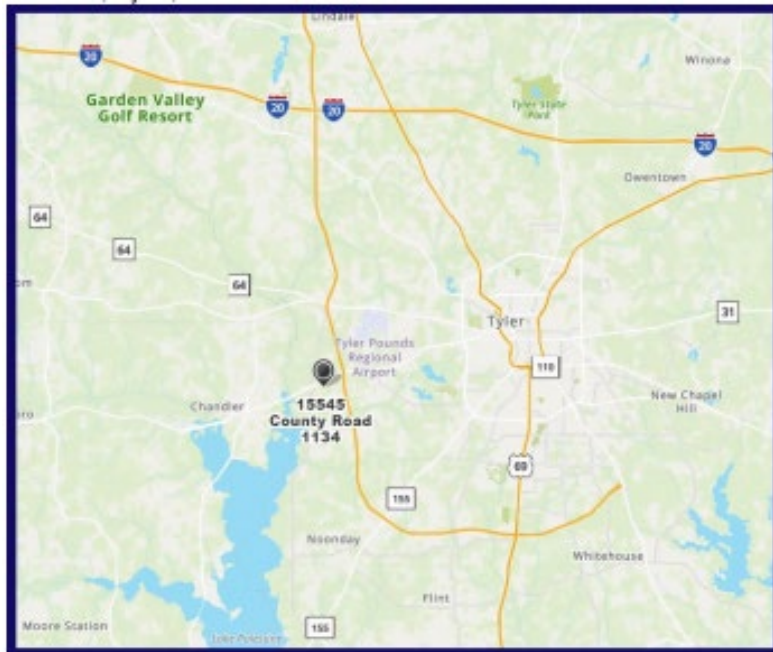

## Directions to Lucky Dog:

- Take I-20 East toward Tyler/Shreveport;
- Travel 53.54 miles on I-20 and take EXIT 553.
- Then travel 0.30 miles and merge onto TX-49 Loop S toward TX-49 S/Tyler (Portions toll). (If you reach County Road 411 you've gone about 0.3 miles too far)
- Then travel 9.57 miles and merge onto State Highway 31/TX-31 W.
- Go 1.58 miles and turn left onto FM 2661/FM-2661. (If you reach County Road 1223 you've gone about 0.3 miles too far)
- Travel 0.17 miles and turn left onto County Road 1134. (County Road 1134 is 0.1 miles past State Highway 31). If you reach County Road 1235 you've gone about 0.3 miles too far.)
- Go .68 miles to 15545 County Road 1134, Tyler, TX 75709-3301
