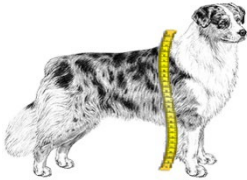

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if

asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our Judge, Diane Fyfe is a Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the ribbon-label table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured.

If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

ARMBAND STICKERS NOT REQUIRED

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. **We will be using the Agility Gate App for check-in on your phone or tablet.... See Page 2 for more information.**

Running Orders and Course Maps

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC rules. Feel free to take pictures of them. Maps for the following day will be posted each night after midnight, on Agility Gate. Some individual maps might be available during the trial.



Arrival/Setup

There is no early set up on Thursday. You may begin setting up at 6:30 am all three days.



IMPORTANT: Unloading/Loading on Fri., Sat. & Sun. will NOT be permitted through the overhead door on the west side of the arena. Unloading/Loading will have to be done through the north doors/ramps to the arena on Burnett-Tandy Drive.

DIRECTIONS TO THE PARC: Exit the show site by going left on Trail Dr. Turn south (right) on University Dr to I-30 W. In approximately 8/10 of a mile, turn right onto West Freeway. Merge onto I-30 West. In approx. .23 miles, take Exit 10 toward Hulen St. Stay on West Freeway and exit (turn left) onto Merrick St. Turn left over freeway and turn left onto the Eastbound service road. The PARC is located on the south side of I-30 east of Merrick Street. (Approximately 5-10 minutes from show site).on the right.

Move-Ups:

The pretrial move-up deadline is Monday, August 15 at 6:00 pm. Please email the trial secretary on or before that date/time for a move up for the trial.

Day-to-day move-ups are permitted at the trials. You must fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday (for a Saturday move-up), and on Saturday (for a Sunday move-up). Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

PARKING AT WATT ARENA

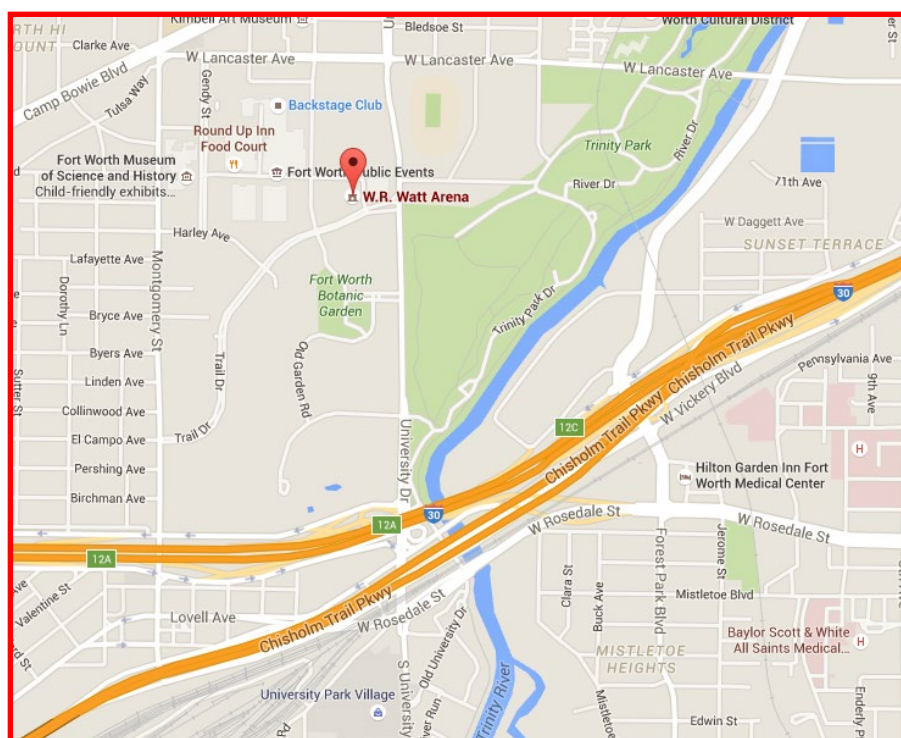

From Interstate 30 just west of downtown Fort Worth, take the UNIVERSITY DR NORTH ramp around and turn left (North) on University Drive. Go .6 miles (6/10 of a mile) to the light at Harley Drive. Turn left onto Harley Drive. The building ahead on the right is Watt Arena.
