DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE FROM PLANO, TX

One-tenth of a mile is an area to turn left onto a driveway by a 2-story yellow house (first left turn after the intersection). Turn left and go down the driveway to the Red OU Barn.

Awards & Prizes

The following Ribbon and Rosette Prizes are offered by Lone Star Dog Obedience Club (LSDOC) through the generosity of its members and friends.

QUALIFYING SCORE REQUIRED FOR ALL PRIZES IN ALL CLASSES.

Class Prizes offered in a given class will be awarded in the ring to the person showing the dog who will be considered to be the owner or authorized agent.

All Prizes MUST be picked up at this show -- none will be mailed.

Awards not claimed at the show become the property of the Club.

LSDOC reserves the right to substitute awards for ones of equal or greater value.

Notices to Exhibitors

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete or be on the trial grounds. If a female is withdrawn from competition because she came into season, the trial secretary must be notified in writing no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. The club will refund the entry fee, less \$5.00 (per trial) processing fee upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary before the start of judging each day.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. All dogs present must be confined to their crates except when being pottied, warmed up, or judged. Dogs being pottied or warmed up must be held on lead. **Exhibitors** are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dog creates unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, refund of any entry fees will not be made.

Handlers WITHOUT DOGS are welcome at ringside to watch Rally Trial judging if space permits. The Rally Trial Committee Members will remind anyone at ringside with a dog that their dog must be crated while in the building or waiting to go into the ring. The ring entrance and exit must be clear at all times. The Rally Trial Committee is committed to the safety of all dogs and handlers, and we thank you in advance for your support.

Exhibitors and guests are responsible for the behavior of any child(ren) who accompanied them. Any exhibitor or guest whose child or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

The Judge will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when they are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive one hour prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not) are not allowed on trial grounds.

The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run.

PARKING INFORMATION VERY IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

Feel Free to park in front of the fence by the gates (head-in parking only). Also, you may park in front of the house -- head-in parking only-but no farther west than where the Silver Chrysler Van and Red Chrysler Van are parked. PLEASE be careful not to pull onto the grass in the front yard of the house. You may not park along the east side of the driveway from Parker Rd. to the building. Cones and No Parking signs will be along the driveway on the east. You may head-in park in the field catty-cornered to the building along the driveway – with all 4 wheels off the driveway to allow for thru traffic. Please be aware that if it has rained, this area might be soft and getting stuck could be an issue. We do not have any equipment to help you get out if you get stuck. Because of the number of people entered, we don't anticipate there being a huge parking issue, but we want you to be aware. If we ask you to move your vehicle, please comply.



IMPORTANT INFO... Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs

(inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.

POOP BAGS are available in a container posted on a telephone post outside the front entry of the building. Please feel free to use them and place full bags in the trash receptacle by the pole.
