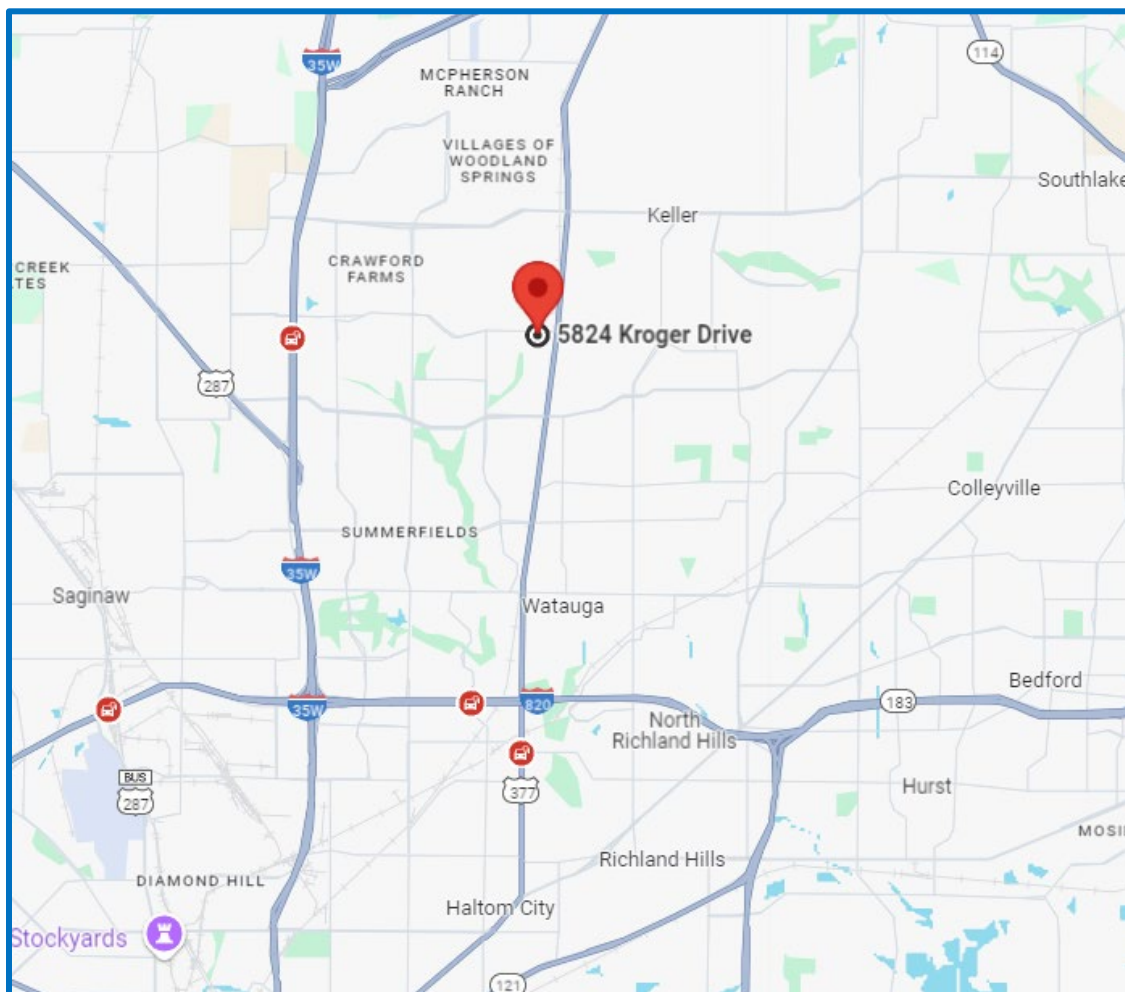

VERY IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION!

PLEASE READ THIS!!!

We could face an unexpected parking problem. Parking is available in front of Lucky Dog and all along the front of the neighboring strip center. Parking is not available behind Lucky Dog or across the street in the Kroger warehouse parking lot. However, we are not sure how many cars will be parked for the other businesses in the center.

If you can carpool with a friend, that would be very helpful. Friday is the most critical day as businesses in the neighboring strip center are open. There could be a business or two in the center that are open on Saturday as well.

We believe parking in front of Lucky Dog and the neighboring strip center will be sufficient if people do not come and stay all day. If people are coming and going throughout the day, parking will probably be okay. **Please DO NOT arrive hours before your runs and stay for hours after your runs. You may leave your crates, etc., from day-to-day.**

Please don't arrive too early and please be prepared to leave after your run(s). **Intermediate and Novice competitors do not have to arrive until afternoon.**

We apologize for this inconvenience. THANK YOU for your patience and understanding.

If you cannot find a parking spot, please call Nancy at 214-695-7470. She will follow you to an offsite parking spot and shuttle you back to the building.

BRING YOUR MATS, PLEASE!

All crates and chairs must be placed on your personal mat. Please be sure your mats are clean. The facility management would appreciate no one bringing dirt on mats into the facility. Chairs must not be placed on the facility's matted flooring without being on a personal mat. All crates and chairs must be on a personal mat.

Chairs may be placed ringside inside the half wall **ONLY** on personal mats. Chairs without personal mats are not allowed inside the half wall surrounding the ring area.

The next dog in the ring may be inside the half wall. Dogs must stay outside the half wall until they are the next dog in.

The ring entrance and exit must be clear at all times. The Rally Trial Committee is committed to the safety of all dogs and handlers, and we thank you in advance for your support.

CRATING IS ALLOWED ONLY IN THE DESIGNATED CRATING ROOM. CRATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED RINGSIDE OR IN THE MAIN ROOM.

Notices to Exhibitors

IF YOUR DOG IS ILL OR EXHIBITING ANY SIGNS OF ILLNESS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, COUGHING, DIARRHEA, OR RESPIRATORY DISTRESS, PLEASE LEAVE THEM AT HOME. ANYONE NOTICING A DOG EXHIBITING SIGNS OF ILLNESS IS REQUIRED TO REPORT IT TO THE EVENT COMMITTEE. ILL DOGS WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EXCUSED AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STAY ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. A MISCONDUCT HEARING COULD BE HELD FOR ANYONE INTENTIONALLY DISRESPECTING THIS REQUIREMENT.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete or be on the trial grounds. If a female is withdrawn from competition because she came into season, the trial secretary must be notified in writing no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. The club will refund the entry fee, less \$5.00 (per trial) as long as written notice is given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of judging each day.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs. All dogs present must be confined to their crates except when being pottied, warmed up, or judged. Dogs being pottied or warmed up must be held on lead. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dog creates unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, refund of any entry fees will not be made.

Exhibitors and guests are responsible for the behavior of any child(ren) who accompanied them. Any exhibitor or guest whose child or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

The Judge will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when they are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive one hour prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not) are not allowed on trial grounds.

The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run.

DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures or is confined without supervision, the authorities will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Event Committee for disciplinary action. The event committee reserves the right to break into a vehicle to rescue a dog in distress. All persons attending these events hereby waive any claim for damages against the host clubs, its members, Show Secretary, or the property owner in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.



IMPORTANT INFO... Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
