CHECK IN & MEASUREMENTS



All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card.

Our Judge, Laura English, is a Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be

measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the ribbon-label table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it.

If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on the gate sheet prior to your class. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN PEN TO CHECK IN. NO COMMUNITY PENS WILL BE AVAILABLE.**

CONCESSIONS

There will not be a concession stand, but there will be a food truck available all 3 days – BBQ on Friday, Mexican on Sat & Sun.



MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted

to the trial secretary via email **no later than Monday, April 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted** if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Arrival & Setup

Set-up will be allowed on **Thursday from 3:00 pm until 7:00 pm. Set up begins at 6:30 am all 3 days.**



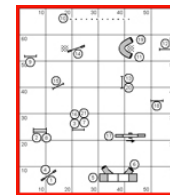

From the show site, get on US 281 North for 1.9 miles. Take the exit toward TX-79 S/TX369/Southwest Pkwy and merge onto Henry S Grace Fwy. Turn left onto the TX-79 S ramp to TX-369 N. Keep left to continue on Southwest Pkwy and travel 1.7 miles. Turn right onto Taft Blvd. Colonial Park Vet Clinic is .2 miles. 6 minute travel time.

Covid Guidelines

The Obedience Training Club of Wichita Falls would like everyone to know we are working on making sure we are providing a safe environment consistent with current guidelines.

1. Mask must be worn except when running your dog.
2. Disposable gloves will be available to course builders, ring crew and any other workers that desire them. We also will have disposable mask available if needed.
3. Hand sanitizer and disinfecting spray will be available around the arena.
4. Avoid common use pens/pencils. Please bring your own.
5. There will be no MACH/PACH cakes or community shared food at the trial. There will be water and some snacks provided for workers.
6. Leash runner will use a "grabber" to pick up the leashes.
7. Walk-thru groups will be reduced.
8. The timer/scribe table, and chairs will be wiped down with disinfectant after each class.
9. Please do not crowd around gate steward area or the results area.
10. Paper copy of maps will not be available. They will be posted at www.ntxagility.com each evening. Maps will also be posted at the show site.
11. Please wash and sanitize your hands.

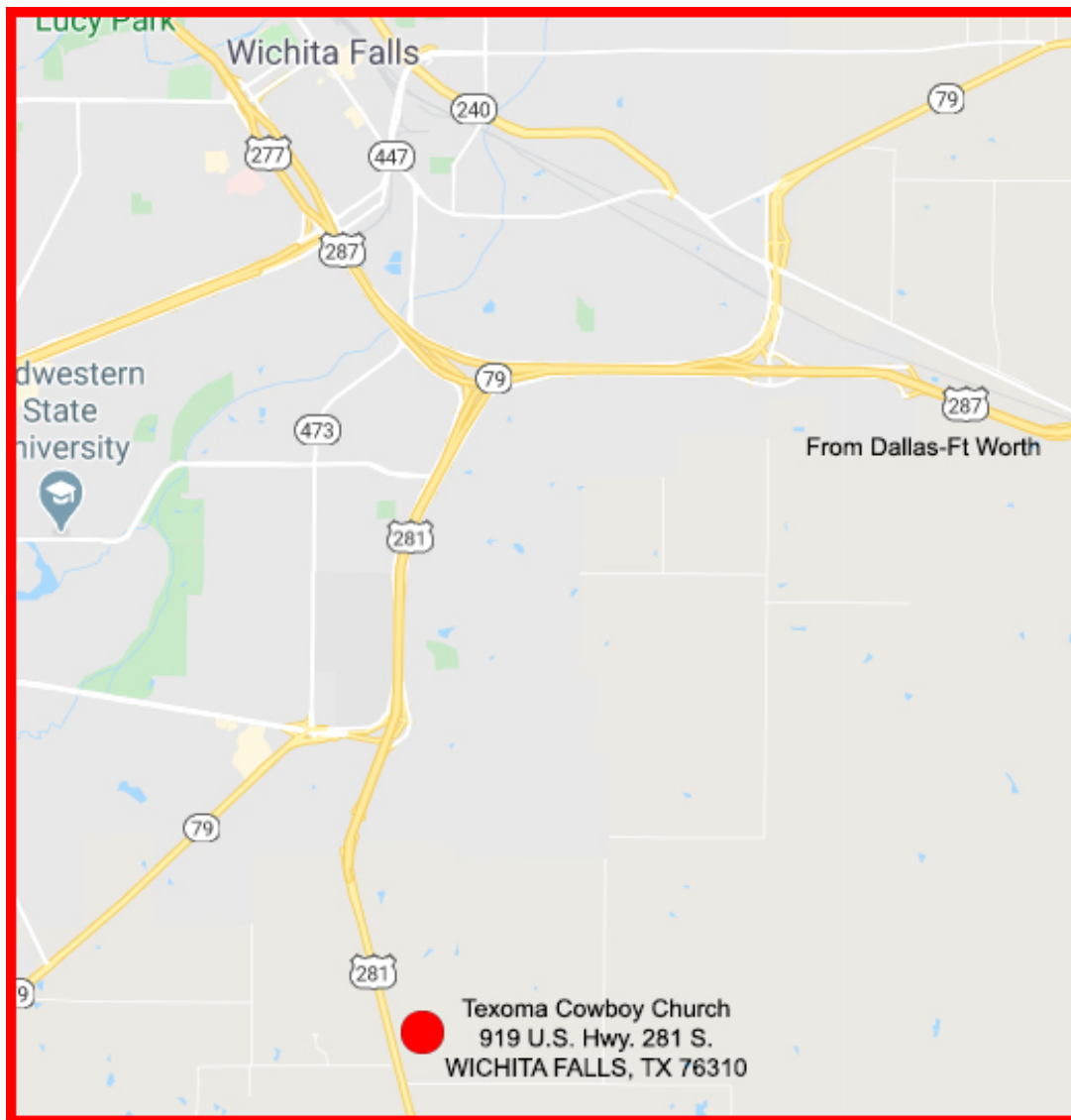
The Trial Site

From the south on Hwy. 287: Take the left at the fork to TX-79 S, follow signs for US 281 S/Jacksboro/Archer City. Cowboy Church will be 3.8 miles down on your left.

From the north on Hwys. 287 or I-44: Past downtown Wichita Falls, use the left 2 lanes to take the US-281 S/TX-79 S exit toward Jacksboro/Archer City. Cowboy Church will be 3.8 miles down on your left.

CRATING IS AVAILABLE IN YOUR CAR, ON CONCRETE OR ON DIRT. FANS AND/OR HEATERS ARE ALLOWED.

A short devotional will be held on Sunday morning prior to the start of the trial.

IMPORTANT INFO...



Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others.
