

CHECK-IN & MEASUREMENTS

All agility dogs are required to have an

Official Jump Height Card.

Our Judge, Laura English, is a Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it.

If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

ARMBAND STICKERS NOT REQUIRED

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be available. Both fast food and restaurants are located within easy driving distance.

No other food or drink is allowed at the show site. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. Use of Coolers: The use of small coolers is permitted for dog treats and dog food ONLY.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups



must be submitted to the trial secretary via email no later than Monday, June 24, 2019 at 6:00 pm. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the ribbon label table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Fri for a Sat move-up, or on Sat. for a Sun. move-up.


ARRIVAL & SETUP-IMPORTANT!

The building will be open for crating at 12:30 pm on Friday, June 28. The building will also be open for crating at 6:45 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Please do not come any earlier than 12:30 p.m. on Friday.

CRATING SPACE WILL BE TIGHT. PLEASE BE COURTEOUS OF OTHER EXHIBITORS AND CONSERVE SPACE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. PLEASE NO MATS OR LARGE LOUNGE CHAIRS. THERE IS PLENTY OF STADIUM SEATING. X-PENS ARE ALLOWED FOR 3 OR MORE DOGS ONLY. THE TRIAL COMMITTEE HAS THE RIGHT TO ASK YOU TO COMPACT YOUR CRATING SPACE. CRATING IS ALLOWED IN THE STADIUM SEATING AREA. THANK YOU IN ADVANCE!

Even if you don't sign up on the volunteer form, your services could be needed.



VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

<u>UNLOADING:</u> You may pull up on the street (Chisholm Trail) outside the Performance Arena and carry your "stuff" into the show site. Please move your vehicle to a parking lot as soon as you have unloaded and come back to set it all up. Please do not stay on the curb outside the arena more than 5-10 minutes, or as long as it takes to unload (not set up) your things. Please be courteous to others needing to unload. **PARKING ALONG THE STREET IS PROHIBITED. THANK YOU.**

<u>PARKING:</u> There are multiple parking lots within a reasonable walking distance to the Performance Arena. If you prefer not to walk, you can use the shuttle (see below).



All hotels/motels have contact info for the Show Committee Please be considerate and clean guests! Do not allow your dogs to foul a hotel room or property! PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. stay when we travel with our dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and wellkept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds.
