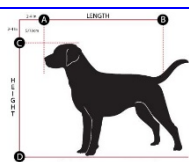

CHECK-IN & MEASUREMENTS

During the COVID pandemic, AKC is not requiring dogs to be measured prior to running.

Gate sheets will be mounted on poster boards for check-in. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN PENS AS NO COMMUNITY PENS WILL BE AVAILABLE.**

Check-In ARMAND STICKERS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on the gate sheet prior to your class.

Concessions will be available. There is also a cafe available, only a short walk away.

You are welcome to bring your own food, drinks and snacks.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than Monday, October 26, 2020 at 6:00 pm.** Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the ribbon label table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Thurs for a Fri move-up, on Fri for a Sat move-up, or on Sat. for a Sun. move-up.

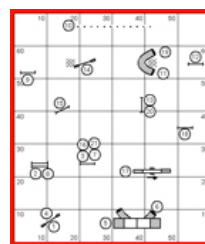


ARRIVAL & SETUP-IMPORTANT!

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION :

UNLOADING: You may pull up on the street (Chisholm Trail) outside the Barn 8 and carry your “stuff” into the show site. **PUT YOUR PARKING PASS (on the next page) ON YOUR DASHBOARD.** Please move your vehicle to a Parking Lot 1B as soon as you have unloaded and come back to set it all up. Please do not stay on the curb outside the arena more than 5-10 minutes, or as long as it takes to unload (not set up) your things. Please be courteous to others needing to unload. **PARKING ALONG THE STREET IS PROHIBITED. THANK YOU.**

PARKING: Agility exhibitors will be allowed to park in the west lot, LOT 1B, at the end of Barn 9. **PUT YOUR PARKING PASS (on the next page) ON YOUR DASHBOARD TO BE GRANTED ACCESS.** The parking lot is about 100 yards away from Barn 8. A golf cart shuttle will transport you back to Barn 8.

SHUTTLE SERVICE: OKCKC is providing shuttle service from all RV and parking lots to Barn 8. Please call this number about 5 minutes before you'll need the shuttle –

Tell them you are an agility competitor and need a ride to or from Barn 8 and give them your location information. The agility shuttle is an 8-passenger golf cart, so there's room for you and your dogs to ride. The shuttle will be available during all agility show hours.

COVID GUIDELINES

The Oklahoma City Kennel Club would like everyone to know we are working on making sure we are providing a safe environment for our dogs and agility community

- We will be following all state, local and facility guidelines.
- Practice Social distancing consistent with current guidelines
- Everyone MUST wear masks at ALL times (except when running your dog, eating, or drinking) Face shields DO NOT count as a mask, if you wear a face shield, you MUST also wear a mask.
- Disposable gloves will be available for course builders, ring crew, and any other worker that desires them.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting spray bottles will be available around the arena
- There will be no MACH/PACH cakes or community shared food items at the trial. There will be water and some snacks provided for workers
- Leash runner will use a “grabber” to pick up leashes. The “grabber” will be disinfected after each run.
- There will be NO briefings for the Excellent/Master/Premier/T2B classes.
- Walk thru groups will be limited to a maximum of 25 people.
- Agility Gate App will be used to check in, scratch, or mark a conflict. No gathering at the Ring Gate will be allowed.
- There will be designated “IN” and “OUT” gates for entering and exiting the rings.
- Course maps will be posted per AKC Agility Regulations. No printed copies of course maps for exhibitors. The trial secretary will post the maps each day to her website the evening before each day of the trial. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate app.

VERY IMPORTANT...

Do not let the horse show interfere with your fun. We have worked out the kinks with the fairground. NO JOKE! No stairs this year! Unloading pass/parking pass is below. We have shuttle to parking and for exercising dogs, additional shuttle to the other buildings for conformation and performance. There will also be a shuttle from RV lot to Bennett building. 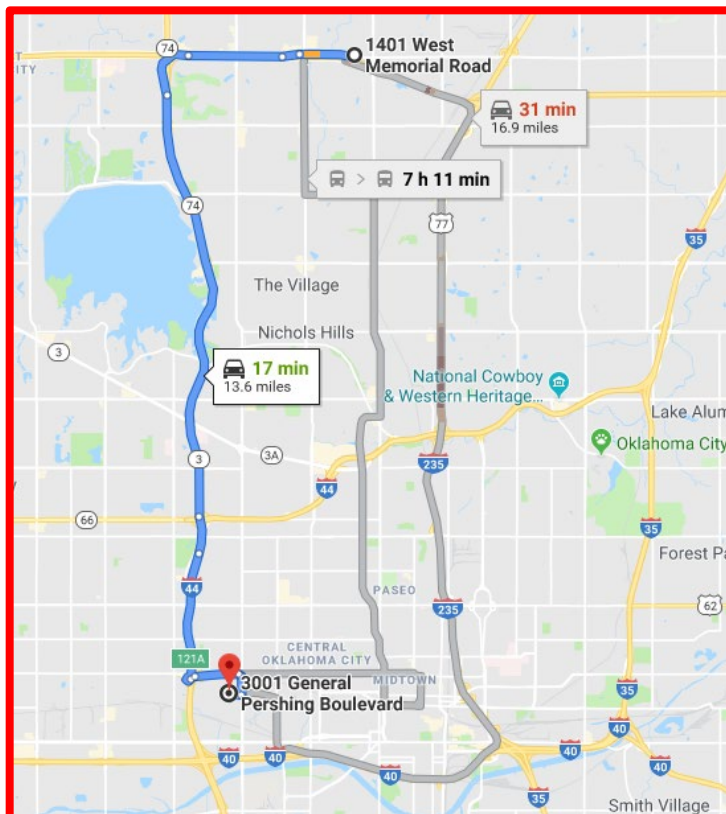

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

RESERVATIONS THIS YEAR ARE ONLY FOR SOUTH LOT AND DRY PARKING.

There is a month-long horse show starting this weekend at the Fairgrounds. Therefore, exhibitors will not be allowed in the West or North parking lots. **DO NOT MAKE A RESERVATION FOR THE SOUTH LOT EXPECTING TO GET INTO THE OTHER LOTS, IT WILL NOT BE TRANSFERABLE.**
