

ENTRY INFORMATION

YOU CAN ENTER THE TRIAL VIA AKC'S ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at <u>www.akc.org/AgilityEntry</u> and follow the instructions there to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event online. (Please note that AKC charges a small processing fee for online entries.) During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 250 online entries and 450 paper entries. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned.
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender. You must waive signature requirements when using services that utilize signature verifications.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.

JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

PLEASE DO NOT SEND A COPY OF YOUR JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY!

ENTRY FORM: The AKC entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to check if your dog needs to be measured. If your dog does not have a valid jump height card or a temporary jump height yellow receipt (for dogs under 2 years of age), please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to **running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

All FAST Classes will be nested and walked/run together pursuant to the amended AKC rules effective January 3, 2017. Novice FAST will have 12 weave poles.

Daily Entry Fees

First entry of each dog (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)\$23.00.....Jr.Handler \$18.00 Additional entry of same dog (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording Fee)....\$13.00Jr.Handler \$11.00

A junior must have an AKC Junior Handler number and be younger than 18 years of age on the day of the trial. Junior Info must be listed on submitted Entry Form for the discount to be effective. The junior must handle the dog in the event to qualify for the reduced entry fee. If the dog is entered under this provision, but the junior does not handle the dog, the owner must pay the regular entry fee as published.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes (prior to closing). A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. PLEASE CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATION! OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the trial's information. CORRECT AKC REGISTRATION NUMBER IS CRUCIAL, ALONG WITH CORRECT JUMP HEIGHT AND CLASSES ENTERED.

NOTE: If you have a spam filter in place on your email account, please add the trial secretary's email address to your accepted address list. If you are not receiving emails from the trial secretary, it is your responsibility to notify the trial secretary to reach a resolution.

Any exhibitor who does not receive a preliminary confirmation within 10 days of mailing a paper entry should contact the Trial Secretary to confirm receipt of paper entry.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary. Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the day's information.

REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time. No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date unless the spot is filled from someone on the wait list (see below).
- The club will provide full refunds less \$10 per day processing fee for bitches in season. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification plus veterinary verification in writing no later than 30 minutes before the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.
- Refunds for \$5 or less will not be made.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Refunds will not be given if handler changes to a junior handler after the trial closes. A junior is defined as someone less than 18 years of age on the first day of the event.

WAIT LIST POLICY

In the event the trial fills, we are offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of FIFTY (50) entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this Premium. Any withdrawals that are received by 6:00 pm the <u>Sunday prior to the first day of the trial will be replaced by a wait listed entry</u> if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm the Sunday prior to the first day of the trial will receive a full refund.

ELIGIBILITY

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Set-Up

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 6:30 am each morning. Volunteers who help unload the equipment trailer may set up on Thursday afternoon.

OBSTACLES

This trial uses electronic timers. All obstacles used conform to the requirements in the most current issue of the AKC Rules and Regulations Applying to Agility.

CONTACT EQUIPMENT HAS RUBBERIZED SURFACES.

RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE

The rings are a minimum of: Standard-100' X 94'; JWW- 100' X 94'. The trial is held indoors on packed dirt in a non-climate-controlled arena. This set of trials may use electronic timers.

TRIAL HOURS

The trial grounds will be open at 6:30 am. Exhibitors should check in at the ring gate before running. Judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. Exact start times and running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials as amended in July 2016, competitors will NOT be required to wear armband stickers.

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing (email is preferred – ntxagility@verizon.net) by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. (See the move-up deadline date on the cover of this premium). Day-to-day move ups are allowed provided the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 20 minutes of the last dog completing the course. Forms will be available at the show site. If notification has been received in writing from the American Kennel Club after the close of entries that the dog is not eligible for the class(es) entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class(es). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing, accompanied by the letter from the AKC and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Email move-up requests must include the following information:

- Your first and last name
- Your dog's call name
- The class and jump height to which you would like your dog moved

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each
 walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All dogs present *must* be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group. Clothing may display the person's
 name, the dog's call name and/or the dog's picture. Titles may not be displayed. Writing or
 graphics on the clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. See AKC Regulations
 for Agility Trials, Chapter 4, Section 16 for additional information.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Park at your own risk.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor
 whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe
 or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the
 trial site. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs <u>may not</u> be left overnight at the trial site.

Classes offered at this trial are listed on the front of this premium. Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between classes allowed at the same set of trials.

Awards

Ribbons/Rosettes: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard, JWW, and FAST class and 1st place in each T2B class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon. New Title rosettes will be available for new titles earned at this trial. MACH and PACH Rosettes, along with a MACH/PACH pole will be available for dogs earning those titles at this trial. **TWO SPECIAL AWARDS ON SATURDAY**: High In Trial Golden Retriever – Large Rosette awarded to the Golden Retriever earning a QQ from Master Standard and Master Jumpers with Weaves in regular height divisions with the fastest combined time AND in Preferred Classes with the fastest combined time.
