# Check-In and Measuring Info Armbands Not Required

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the <u>mandatory</u> use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. DPOCM is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not required. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

#### **REVISED:**

Our judge and Catherine Clifton are Measuring Officials. ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured.

If your dog needs to be measured, it is YOUR responsibility to have a measurement done prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

# CONCESSIONS NOT AVAILABLE

Concessions will **NOT** be available at the trial. Both fast food and restaurants are located within easy driving distance. Please feel free to bring your own snacks, drinks and lunch.

## **MOVE-UPS**

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email

no later than 6:00 PM Monday, September 11. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 10:30 am on Friday, at 7:30 am on Saturday and Sunday.

# MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE FROM I-20...


WESTBOUND: Take Exit 135 (Cotton Flat Road). The Horseshoe will be on the right.
