Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't

forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it. There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it will only get you through the weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to check-in. It will be open all day. We will do measurements before either Novice or Open. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In

(Armbands Not Required)

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials (Revised July 2016), DenTex will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

Be sure to check in on the Gate Sheet in your ring prior to running.

We start unloading the trailer at 6:00 am Saturday morning. If anyone would like to help, it would be greatly appreciated.


Concessions...

BARNHUNT & AGILITY...



The Trial Site

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles northeast of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM 1461. Turn right (north) on FM 1461 and travel approximately 2.8 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go about 0.8 miles (8/10 of a mile) to the site which is on the left.

**NOTE: Per new FAST rules effective January 3, 2017, All FAST courses (Exc/Mas, Open, Novice) will be nested.

Exc/Mas will walk/run first. Open/Novice will walk together after Exc/Mas FAST has concluded. There will not be a course build in between. Open will be immediately followed by Novice – no walk thru or course build in between Open and Novice.

Novice FAST will have 12 weave poles (which are optional to perform on a FAST course).

PLEASE BE AWARE....

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel or show facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Pease clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
