

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card. Our Judge Ms. Evans is a Volunteer (VMO) All dogs

Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so



your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email no later than Monday, April 9, 2018 at 6:00

pm. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Workers receive a \$4 voucher good to use for lunch at the concession stand, toward your next entry or at the Worker's Raffle!



The Trial Site

From the south on Hwys. 287, 281 or I-44: From Highway 287, take the 6TH ST exit toward M P E C. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto 6TH ST/TX-479-SPUR E. Take the 2nd LEFT onto TRAVIS ST. If you reach LAMAR ST you've gone a little too far. Take the 1st LEFT onto 5TH ST/TX-479-SPUR W. If you reach 4TH ST you've gone a little too far. 1000 5TH ST is on the RIGHT. You'll be able to see the big blue buildings.

From the north on Hwys. 287, 281 or I-44: Take the US-277-BR exit, EXIT 1A. Stay STRAIGHT to go onto US-277-BR S/BROOK AVE. Continue to follow BROOK AVE. Turn LEFT onto US-277-BR N/6TH ST/TX-479-SPUR E. Continue to follow 6TH. Take the 1st LEFT onto 5TH ST/TX-479-SPUR W. If you reach 4TH ST you've gone a little too far. 1000 5TH ST is on the RIGHT. If you reach AUSTIN ST you've gone a little too far. You'll be able to see the big blue buildings.



PLEASE WALK YOUR DOG ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS. LANDSCAPED AREAS ARE OFF LIMITS - There will be signs.

PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

Other Important Information:

- There are entrances to the Coliseum on the North side and North end of the building that go directly into the
 arena level without having to climb the stairs out front. Parking is not allowed in the small parking lot on the
 North end of the building. Please unload, then move your car.
- This is a large facility with plenty of room if used wisely and courteously.
- Crating is allowed on the Arena Floor Level and on the Upper Concourse Level.
- We ask that you be mindful of where you set up that you are not blocking walk space, hallways or exits. The fire marshal will be coming around and will ask you to move if you are in violation.
- Mats are not allowed (or necessary) in any crating area, as all crating is on concrete.
- Chairs are fine as long as they are not the big lounge chairs.
- There is plenty of stadium seating in the spectator stands.
- Please be considerate of other competitors and don't use more space than needed.

The club reserves the right to ask anyone to move and/or condense their crating space.
