Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. RDAC is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in at the gate on the gate sheet prior to your class.

MEASURING



All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

There will be not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it will only get you through the weekend. All exhibitors who checked on the entry form that their dog needs to be measured must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). If you are entered in Novice or Open, you do not have to get there early to be measured. The judges will do measurements before either Novice or Open.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

CONCESSIONS!

Concessions will be available Saturday and Sunday during lunch hours.

Hours will be posted during the trial.

Both fast food and restaurants are located within easy driving distance. No outside food or drink is allowed on Saturday or Sunday. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up!



Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email no later than 6:00 PM Monday, January 8. Dayto-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Arrival & Setup

Set up is not allowed on Thursday, January 11.

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 7:00 am on Friday and at 6:30 am Sat and Sun. The facility WILL NOT be available to exhibitors prior to Friday morning.





The park features 284 full-service hook ups and 500 additional limited service spaces. The park also features recently remodeled comfort stations with laundry and shower facilities. Rate: \$25/night

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
