Check-In MEASURING

There will be no measuring of dogs. If an AKC rep happens to come to the trial (not expected), they can choose to either measure dogs or not. If they do, the devices and table will be wiped down between dogs and they must sanitize their hands between dogs. The dog will need to be able to stand on the table with the handler 6 feet away.

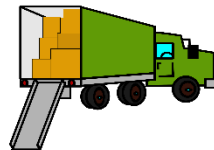
MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up!

Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than**

6:00 PM Monday, January 4. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

Arrival & Setup



Set up is allowed from 5:00 pm until 6:30 pm on Thursday, January 7.

The building will be open at 9:00 am on Friday and at 6:45 AM on Saturday & Sunday

We must maintain social distancing, so crating should be 6 feet apart, except for families and people traveling together.

Course maps will be posted per AKC Agility Regulations. **There will be no printed copies of course maps for exhibitors.** Exhibitors may take a picture of the posted course maps. Also, maps will be posted to the North Texas Agility website around 6:00 pm each evening before the next trial day. www.ntxagility.com and on the Agility Gate App.

A preliminary running order will be posted on the www.ntxagility.com website on or before Wednesday prior to the first day of the trial. No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the Agility Gate App for check-in on your phone.... **See Page 3 for more information.**

COVID GUIDELINES

Red Dirt Agility Club would like everyone to know we are working on making sure we are providing a safe environment for our dogs and agility community.

- ** We will be following all state, local and facility guidelines.** (Keep in mind, these are constantly changing)
- ** Practice social distancing** consistent with current guidelines.
- ** Everyone must wear masks at all times (except when running your dog or eating or drinking.)** Face shields do not count as a mask, if you wear a face shield, you must also wear a mask.
- ** Disposable gloves will be available** for course builders, ring crew, & any other worker that desires them.
- ** Hand sanitizer and disinfecting spray bottles will be available** around the arena.
- ** Bathrooms will be stocked** with plenty of soap, hand sanitizer, and disinfecting spray bottles.
- ** Crating should be 6 ft apart** except for “family” or “traveling” units of people.
- ** There will be no common use writing utensils.** Please bring your own.
- ** Gate Sheets will not be used.** The running orders will be on Agility Gate. No paper gate sheets will be available for check-in. Paper running orders will be posted for reference.
- ** There will be no MACH cakes or community-shared food items at the trial.** There will be water and some snacks provided for workers. All workers will also receive \$4 coupon good for food at the snack bar or entries at a future trial.
- ** There will be no self-serve ribbons.** We will have a volunteer putting the sticker on the ribbons for you.
- ** There will be a 6 ft area marked off around the gate steward.** Please do not go into this area! The gate steward will be in charge of getting the dogs in the correct order to enter the ring. There will be a designated area for “on deck”, in-the-hole”, & “3rd in line.” No congregating will be allowed in the ring area. A few people will be allowed to video.
- ** Leash runner will use a “grabber” to pick up leashes.** The “grabber” will be disinfected after each run. Note: exhibitors may put their leash in their pocket or “wear” them (i.e. clip like a belt around the waist) during their run. Leash must fully fit in their pocket. Please be aware that if the dog grabs the leash while running, this will be scored as an “E”.

- ** **Course builders will be provided disposable gloves** if they want them. They should make sure and wipe down the measuring wheel before and after use. They should not share course building maps with others. Please check with the Chief Course Builder for each ring, before you step in to help course build.
- ** **Timer and scribe will sit at opposite ends of the table.** Scribe should use their own pen for marking the scribe sheets. The table, chairs, and timing console will be wiped down with disinfectant after each group of workers.
- ** **There will be NO briefings for the Excellent/Master/Premier/T2B classes.** There will be a judge's briefing before all Novice and Open.
- ** **There will be no measuring of dogs.** If an AKC rep happens to come to the trial, they can choose to either measure dogs or not. If they do, the devices and table will be wiped down between dogs and they must sanitize their hands between dogs. And dog will need to be able to stand on the table with the handler 6 feet away.
- ** **Walk-thru group sizes will be reduced.** There will be approximately 25 people per walk-thru.
- ** **Monitors to view results during the runs will be on close to the trial secretaries.** Only one person at a time may look at the monitors. All others must for a line, keeping 6 feet between people. This method will continue unless violations recur. If these rules are violated, the monitors will be removed.
- ** **Results will be posted in a convenient place.** Please look at the results and if there are any questions, please ask the trial secretary about any discrepancies. Please do not crowd around the results area! Results from the day before will be posted on the www.ntxagility.com website each evening. They will NOT be put in a notebook.
- ** **Course maps will be posted per AKC Agility Regulations.** There will be no printed copies of course maps for exhibitors. Exhibitors may take a picture of the posted course maps. In addition to the course maps that are posted at the trial site, the trial secretary will post the maps each day to her website – www.ntxagility.com -- the evening before each day of the trial. Course maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App. You can use your phone or iPad to view the maps.

We will be utilizing the [AGILITY GATE APP](#)
for the exhibitors' convenience.

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

The access code is 0108.

Course maps will be posted on the Agility Gate App as well as at www.ntxagility.com each evening prior to the trial.

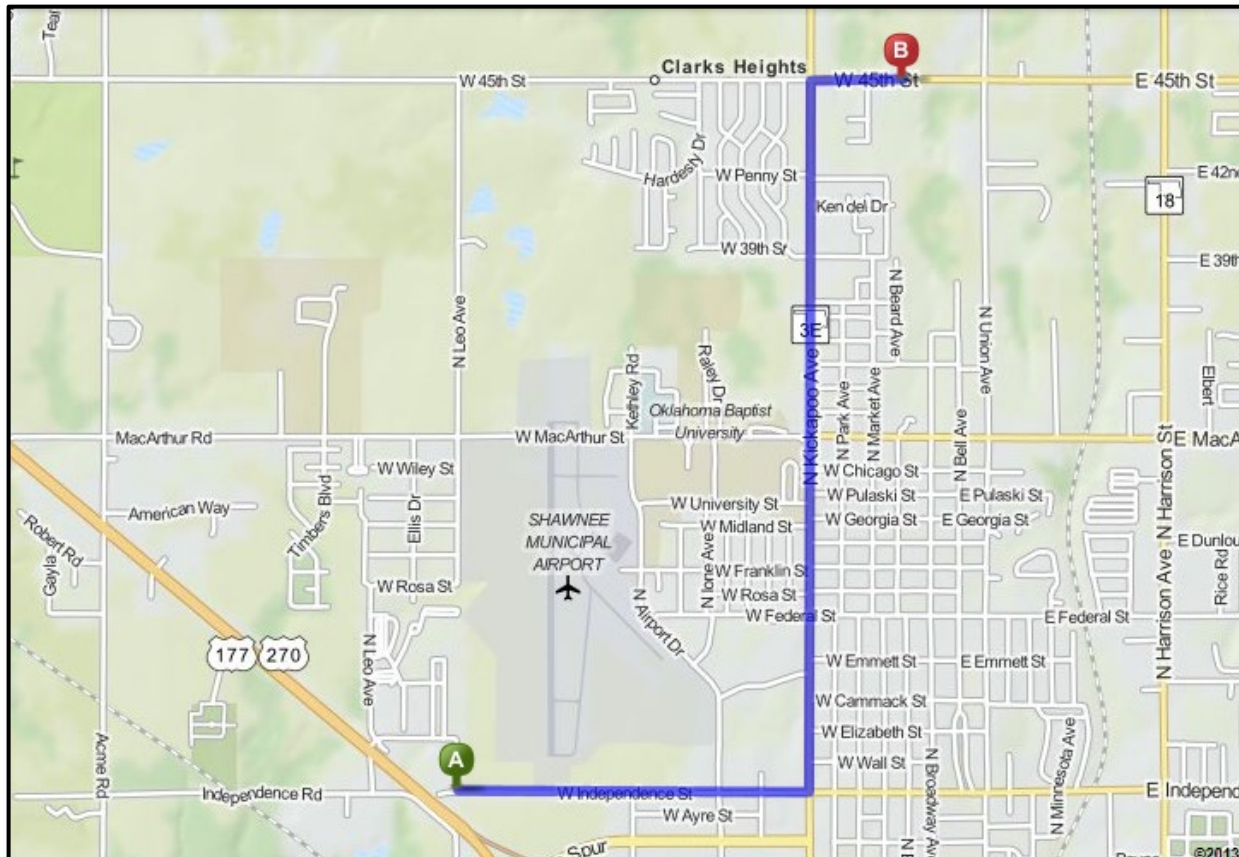

The park is on-site at the Expo Center and features 284 full-service hook ups and 500 additional limited service spaces. The park also features recently remodeled comfort stations with laundry and shower facilities.



Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others.
