### Check-In and MEASURING

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card.

**Our Judge, Tim Pinneri is a Measuring Official (VMO).** ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the ribbon-label table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it.

If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

### ARMBAND STICKERS NOT REQUIRED

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on Agility Gate on your phone or tablet. **See more information about Agility Gate on Page 2 below.**

### CONCESSIONS!

Concessions will be available during trial hours on Saturday and Sunday only. Both fast food and restaurants are located within easy driving distance.

### MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up!

Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than 6:00 PM Monday, January 3.** **Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted** if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.

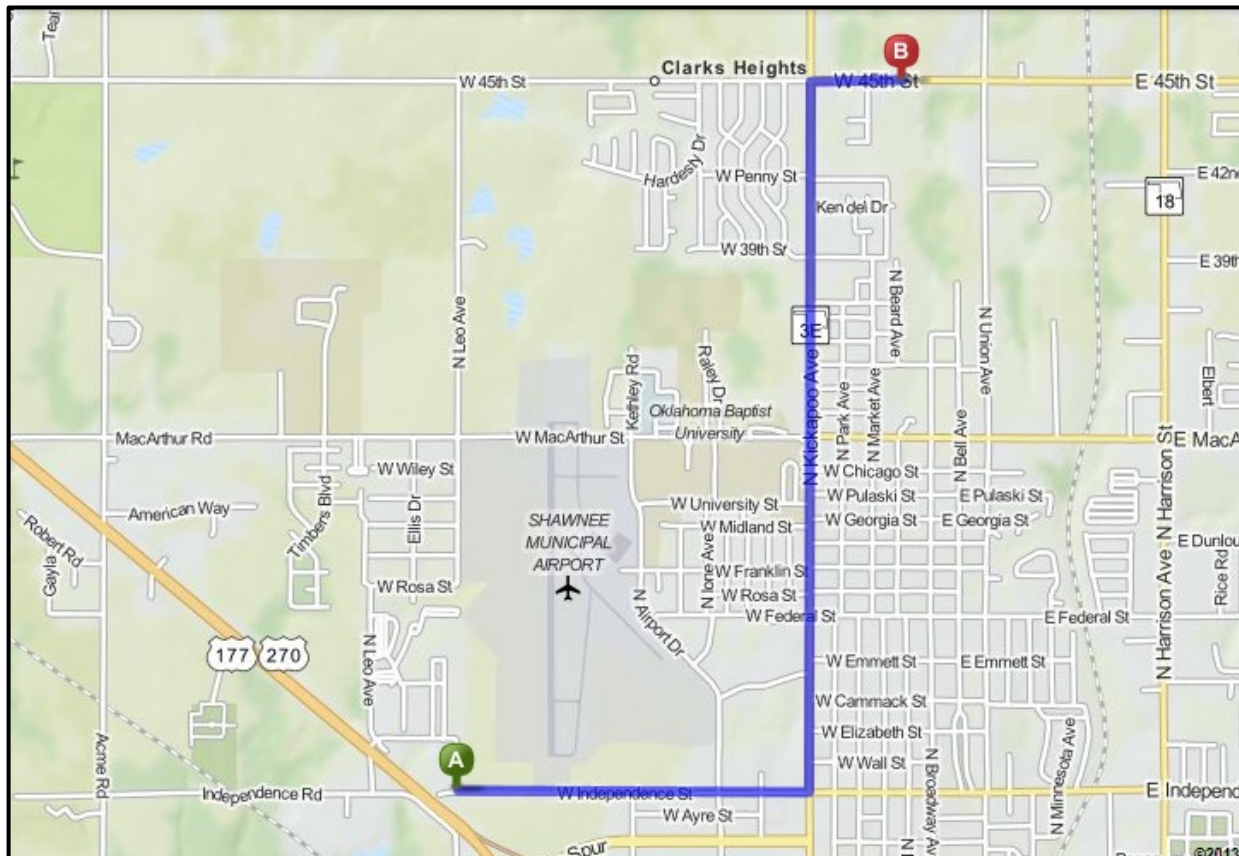

The park is on-site at the Expo Center and features 284 full-service hook ups and 500 additional limited service spaces. The park also features recently remodeled comfort stations with laundry and shower facilities.



Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

**PLEASE REMEMBER:** Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others.
