### **UNLOADING & LOADING**

1. The Complex unloading and loading should be done at the North, South or West entrances.
  - The North entrance is most convenient to the Rally Ring and the crating areas surrounding the Rally Ring.
  - The South entrance is most convenient to the two Obedience Rings and the crating areas directly across from the Obedience Rings.
  - The West (canopied) double door entrance provides convenient access to the Rally Ring, the Obedience Rings and to all crating areas.
2. Exhibitors are required to unload and remove their vehicles as quickly as possible from the unloading/loading areas. Equipment set up can be done after the vehicle has been removed.
3. Members of the Trial Committee will monitor unloading on Thursday, April 16, 2026 and loading on Sunday, April 19, 2026.

### **PARKING**

1. Parking is provided on a first come, first served basis at **NO CHARGE**.
2. Approximately 150 parking spaces are available on the North and West sides of The Complex.
3. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk.
4. Unlawfully parked vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.
5. All vehicles must be removed from The Complex immediately following the awarding of High in Trial or the conclusion of all judging (whichever is later) on Sunday, April 19, 2026.

## **ROUTES TO THE SHOW SITE**

### **From the DFW Area**

Take Sam Rayburn (121) Tollway N to US-75 N then exit to TX-121 N. Continue to TX-311 Spur N on left which intersects with TX 56 W. Turn Left onto TX 56 W. In approximately 1.5 miles turn Right on to FM 87 N and then Right into the Complex.

**Alternate Route** from US-75 N from Dallas to Sherman, TX. Exit to HWY 82 E Continue 22.3 miles. Exit 644 to FM 87 S. Turn Right then destination entrance will be on your Left in 2.7 miles.

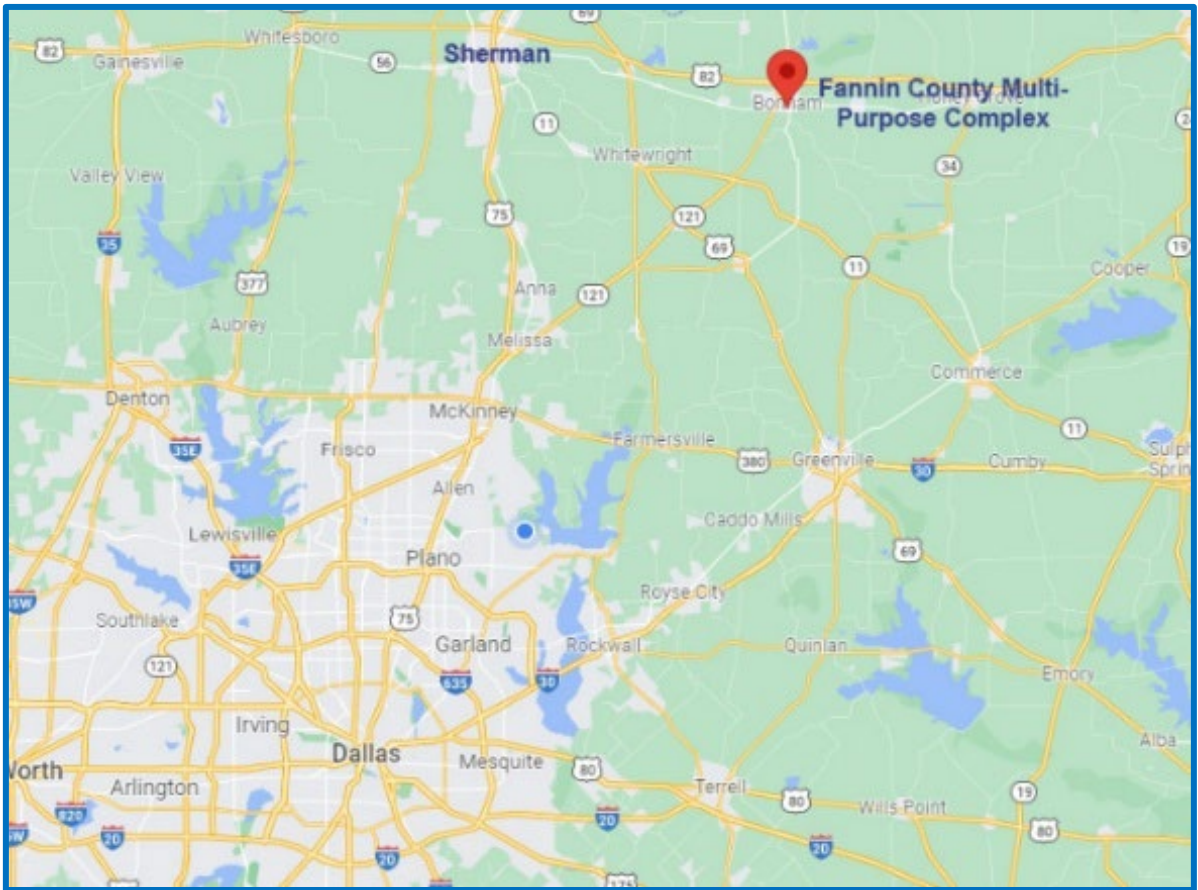
### **From the North**

I-75 S to Exit 63 in Sherman-Denison to merge onto N HWY 75 N Sam Rayburn FWY. Turn Left onto HWY 82 E. Continue 22.3 miles. Exit 644 to FM 87 S. Turn Right then destination entrance will be on your left in 2.7 miles.

### **From the East**

**From East on I-30** at Sulphur Springs, take Exit 122 towards Industrial Dr. W / Frontage Road to merge Right onto Hillcrest Dr. (TX-11). Continue North to Houston St. and turn Left onto TX-11 W. Follow TX-11 W through Commerce to FM 2815 N in Fannin County. Turn Right onto FM 2815. In approximately 4 miles, turn Left onto FM 1629 then Right onto TX-121 N. In 2.5 miles, turn Left onto TX-311 Spur N which intersects with TX 56 W. Turn Left onto TX 56 W. In approximately 1.5 miles turn Right on to FM 87 N and then Right into the Complex. **From the East on I-20** take Exit 556 towards Lindale, keep Right at the fork and merge onto S. Main Street (US-69). Follow North through Greenville until you reach FM 896 in Leonard. Turn Right onto FM 896 and continue North to Randolph. Turn Right on Queener St. then Left onto TX-11 W then turn Right onto TX-121 Business North to merge onto TX-121 N. Turn Left onto TX-311 Spur N which intersects with TX 56 W. Turn Left onto TX 56 W. In approximately 1.5 miles turn Right on to FM 87 N and then Right into the Complex.

## THE TRIAL SITE RULES – VERY IMPORTANT

For purposes of these trials, the Fannin County Multi-Purpose Complex with the surrounding grounds is considered trial grounds.

As such, any damage or disrepair caused by exhibitors or their dogs to these properties will result in an Event Committee Hearing and may result in disciplinary action.

### EXERCISING DOGS AT SITE:

1. **THESE ARE SELF CLEANING TRIALS.** Although trash receptacles, clean-up equipment and plastic bags will be provided, it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to bring your own tools for clean-up after your dogs.
2. **DESIGNATED EXERCISE AREAS** are located in the large grass fields just beyond the parking areas west and north of the facility. The large open grass fields to the far west and far north sides of the facility are also available for exercising dogs on long lines or flexi leashes. The large grassy area immediately east of the building which extends east of the north parking area is available for exercising dogs, as well. Please dispose of waste properly in the outside receptacles that are provided around The Complex.
3. **DO NOT** exercise dogs in the grass immediately adjacent to **any** exterior walls of the building.
4. **ABSOLUTELY** do not allow dogs to urinate on interior facility walls, posts, ring gates or trash cans or exterior walls or posts.

### CHILDREN AT SITE:

1. **NO BUGGIES OR STROLLERS ARE ALLOWED.**
2. Children in harnesses or similar devices must be kept close at the side of the supervising adult.
3. The parents or supervising adult will be solely responsible for the behavior, welfare and safety of their children and any damages caused by their children. Parents whose children create unnecessary disturbances or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave The Complex.
4. NO unaccompanied children will be allowed entry into the trial building.

### SECURITY:

1. Security will NOT be provided.
2. The Lone Star Dog Obedience Club, Inc., the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., as well as the Fannin County Multi-Purpose Complex assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children or damage caused by a dog.
3. All persons attending these dog trials, hereby waive any claims for damages against the Lone Star Dog Obedience Club, Inc., the Trial Secretary or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

### BUILDING RULES:

1. The entire Fannin County Multi-Purpose Complex is a **NON-SMOKING** complex.
2. Alterations of any kind that could mar or deface The Complex are **NOT ALLOWED**.
3. Nails, hooks, tacks, screws or any other hardware cannot be driven or installed into any part of The Complex. Altering the structure of the facility is **ABSOLUTELY NOT PERMITTED**.
4. No flammable materials such as bunting, tissue paper, crepe paper, etc. are permitted. Candles, if used, must be in approved containers.
5. Helium balloons are **NOT** allowed in the facility.
6. Skates (including shoes with rollers), skateboards & scooters or golf carts are not allowed, with the exception of ADA approved aids.
7. Dumping dog food in the restroom sinks or toilets is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
8. **Dogs are not allowed in the Kitchen/Hospitality Area, Restrooms or in the Judges Hospitality Area of the building.**



**IMPORTANT INFO...** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damage to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

**PLEASE REMEMBER:** Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
