## WHEN HEADING WEST ON MARSHA SHARP

The Red line indicates Construction between Upland and FM 179 with road closure. Please use alternate route when coming from Marsha Sharp Freeway (US62/82) as indicated by the green line. Exit upland avenue, turn right on Upland avenue and left on 66th St SPOTC sign will be located at this intersection. Then make a right on Alcove Avenue and make a left into the Texas Tech Equestrian Center.


## WHEN HEADING SOUTH ON FM 179

The Red line indicates construction between Upland and FM 179 with road closure. When heading south on FM179 Continue past 50th St (closed road) and make a left on 66th St.

Then make another left on Alcove Avenue and then a left into the Texas Tech Equestrian Center.

If you have a problem finding the building, put this address in your GPS: 5712 Alcove Ave, Lubbock, TX 79407
ABOUT THE SHOW SITE: The Texas Tech Equestrian Center is an Indoor Arena with a Dirt arena surface. It is not climate controlled. Please park in designated Exhibitor parking areas only. Parking is a short distance from the arena, you may want to bring a cart/dolly.

INDOOR SET UP RESTRICTIONS: No matting allowed on concrete. Matting is allowed on the dirt. Please cover crates with sheet from home. Please endeavor to keep barking at a minimum.
