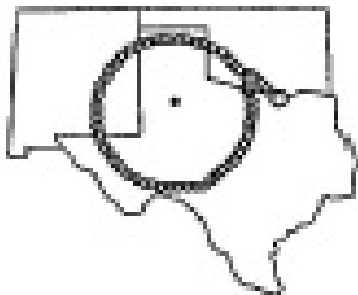

Check-In and Measuring Info...

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our judge is **Not a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)**. Unless an AKC Rep is present (not expected), there will not be a Measuring Official at this trial. Measurements will not be official -- it is only to make sure you are in the correct jump height for this weekend. All exhibitors who do not have a permanent height card or temporary (yellow) measurement form must be measured before running (unless you're jumping 24"). Measurements will be taken all day between classes. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In

ARMBAND STICKERS NOT REQUIRED

The Club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in on your phone or iPad.... See Page 2 for more information.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than 6:00 PM Monday, April 22, 2024**. **Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted** if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line on Friday for a Saturday move-up or on Saturday for a Sunday move-up.



Arrival & Setup

We will begin unloading the trailer about 3:30 on Thursday. **If you are not willing to help with the setting up of the rings on Thursday, please DO NOT set up your crates OR save places for people that have not yet arrived!!** Regular set up begins at 7:00 AM each morning.

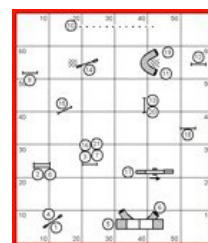
EMERGENCY/ DISASTER PROCEDURES:

We will be utilizing the **AGILITY GATE APP**

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders remotely. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

Course maps will be posted on the Agility Gate App each morning prior to the trial.

MAP AND DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE...



FROM WEST LOOP 289: Take the Marsha Sharp Freeway Exit and go west to Upland Avenue. Go right on Upland Avenue, 1 mile on Upland to 50th Street. Left at the Stop sign on 50th St. Go west on 50th St. 1 mile to Alcove Ave. Left on Alcove, and go south ½ mile to the entrance to the Equestrian Center. Proceed to the parking lot

FROM HWY 62/82 SOUTHWEST OF LUBBOCK: Turn north on to Upland Avenue and travel 1.1 miles to the Stop sign at 50th Street. Turn left on 50th St., and go 1 mile to Alcove Ave. Turn left on Alcove and go south ½ mile to the entrance to the Equestrian Center. Proceed to the parking lot.

ABOUT THE SHOW SITE: The Texas Tech Equestrian Center is an Indoor Arena with a Dirt arena surface. It is not climate controlled. Please park in designated Exhibitor parking areas only. Parking is a short distance from the arena, you may want to bring a cart/dolly.

INDOOR SET UP RESTRICTIONS: No matting allowed on concrete. Matting is allowed on the dirt. Please cover crates with sheet from home. Please endeavor to keep barking at a minimum.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION...

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.
