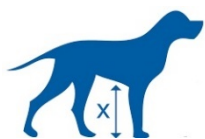

Measuring



All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and must be able to present it if

asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Our Judge Jan Skurzynski is a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO). ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the check-in table. Please fill out a form before requesting to be measured. Ms. Skurzynski will measure dogs in between classes throughout the day.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Check-In

ARMBANDS NOT REQUIRED

Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials has been amended to eliminate the mandatory use of identifying stickers/armbands worn by agility exhibitors. The Club is not requiring armband stickers.

Traditional check-in is not necessary. Please check in on the Agility Gate App.

MOVE-UPS

Be sure to let the trial secretary know if you've earned a new title since you entered the trial so your dog can be moved up! Pre-trial move-ups must be submitted to the trial secretary via email **no later than 6:00 PM Monday, August 2. Day-to-Day Move-Ups are permitted** if you fill out a move-up form (available at the check-in table) and give it to the trial secretary at any time, but no later than 20 minutes after the last dog crosses the finish line to be moved-up for the following day.



Arrival & Setup

The Arena will be available for exhibitor set up from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Thursday, August 5, and at 7:00 am each day thereafter. If you will help unload the trailer, you can set up at 5:00 pm on Thursday. Please do not save spaces for people who are not present helping unload & set up! **There is limited air-conditioned crating space in the Banquet Hall across from the concession stand.**

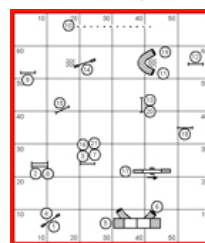

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring.

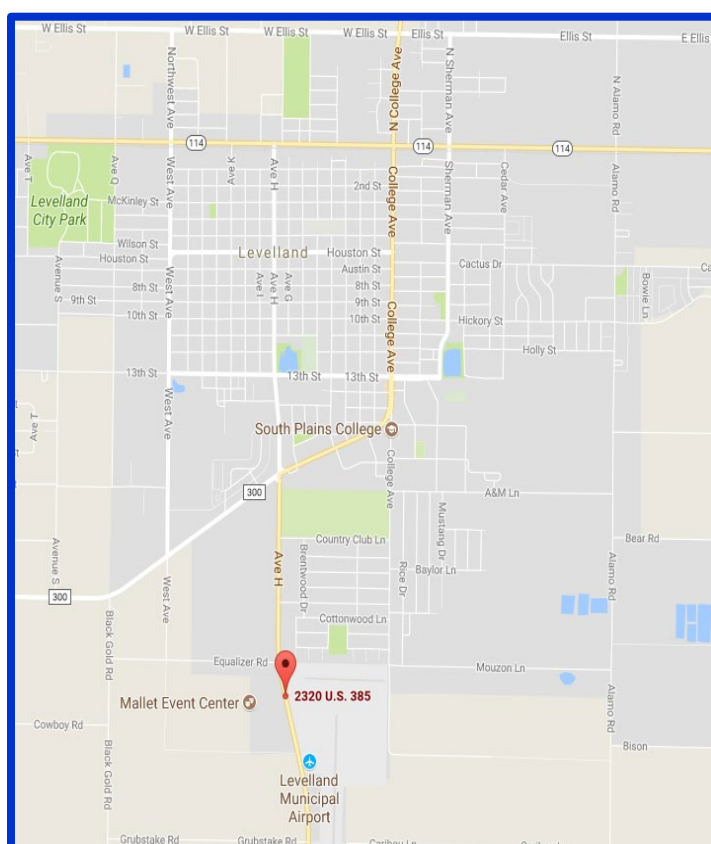
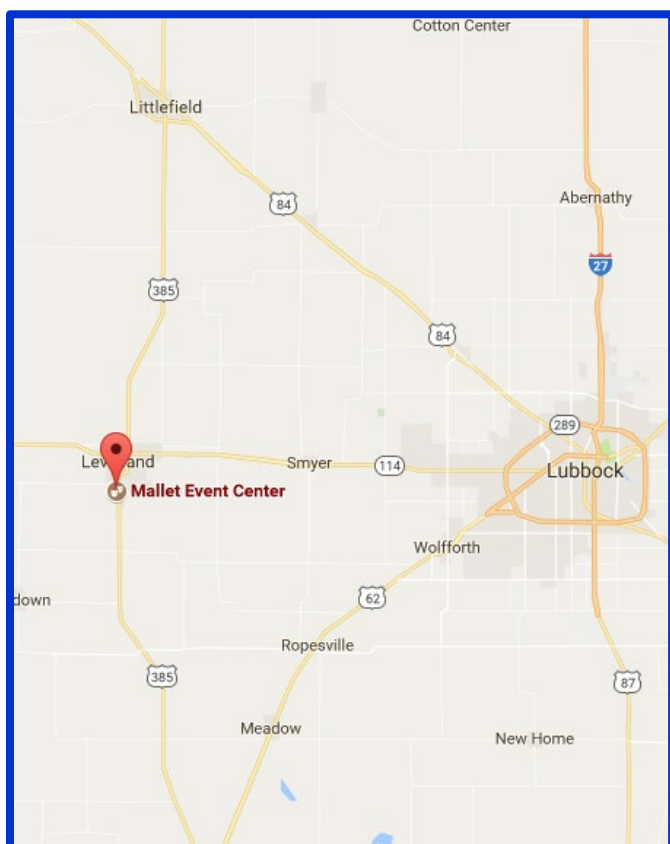

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:

From Hwy 84 (East or West) Take the US-385 ramp (south). Turn onto US-385/Hall Ave and continue south approximately 23 point 7 miles. When arriving at the Hwy 385/ FM 300 intersection, turn left. The Mallet Event Center will be on the right.

From 289 Loop in Lubbock Exit 19th street (Texas Highway 114 West.) Continue approximately 24.5 miles .Travel through town. When arriving at the Hwy 385/FM 300 intersection, turn left. The Mallet Event Center will be on the right.

From Brownfield Travel north on Hwy 385 towards Levelland. The Mallet Event Center will be on the left hand side of the road, across from the airport.

EXHIBITOR PARKING – Parking is free. Park at your own risk. **PLEASE DO NOT** leave dogs in any vehicle. The show committee reserves the right to break into any vehicle to rescue animals in distress.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION...

EXHIBITOR CRATING; INDOOR SET UP RESTRICTIONS: Crating is allowed in the air-conditioned Banquet Hall across from the concession stand. Please do not use mats in this area, as it poses a tripping hazard. X-pens are NOT allowed in the Banquet Hall. Crating is also allowed around the rings on the dirt. Mats are allowed on the dirt. Please cover crates if needed to keep barking at a minimum. No hi-backed lounge chairs allowed at ring side.

ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS OFF-LEAD ON THE ENTIRE MALLETT CENTER GROUNDS INCLUDING EMPTY PADDOCKS AND CORRALS. THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS AT THE PRACTICE JUMP AND IN THE RINGS. VIOLATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO TRIAL COMMITTEE ACTION.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain hotel premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner and for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities.

Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Trial Committee and reported to the AKC. This is an AKC-supported measure.

PLEASE REMEMBER: Hotels do not have to allow us to keep our dogs in the rooms. We are all responsible for insuring future pet acceptance at our favorite hotels. Please clean up after your dogs (inside and outside), keep them quiet so as not to disturb other guests, and generally be considerate of others. We all want to continue to have nice places to stay when we travel with our dogs.



DON'T FORGET – YOU CAN CHECK IN, DESIGNATE A CONFLICT, OR MARK YOUR DOG AS ABSENT ALL ON THE AGILITY GATE APP!

Please use the App so the gate steward is aware of issues.

COVID GUIDELINES

The South Plains Obedience Training Club would like everyone to know we are working on making sure we are providing a safe environment for our dogs and agility community

- We will be following all state, local and facility guidelines.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting spray bottles will be available around the ring.
- Masks are optional for fully-vaccinated people. Masks are highly recommended for walk-thrus.
- Walk thru groups will be limited when necessary.
- Agility Gate App will be used to check in, scratch, or mark a conflict. No gathering at the Ring Gate will be allowed.
- There will be designated “IN” and “OUT” gates for entering and exiting the rings.
- Course maps will be posted per AKC Agility Regulations. No printed copies of course maps for Exhibitors. The trial secretary will post the maps each day to her website at www.ntxagility.com the Evening before each day of the trial. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate app.
